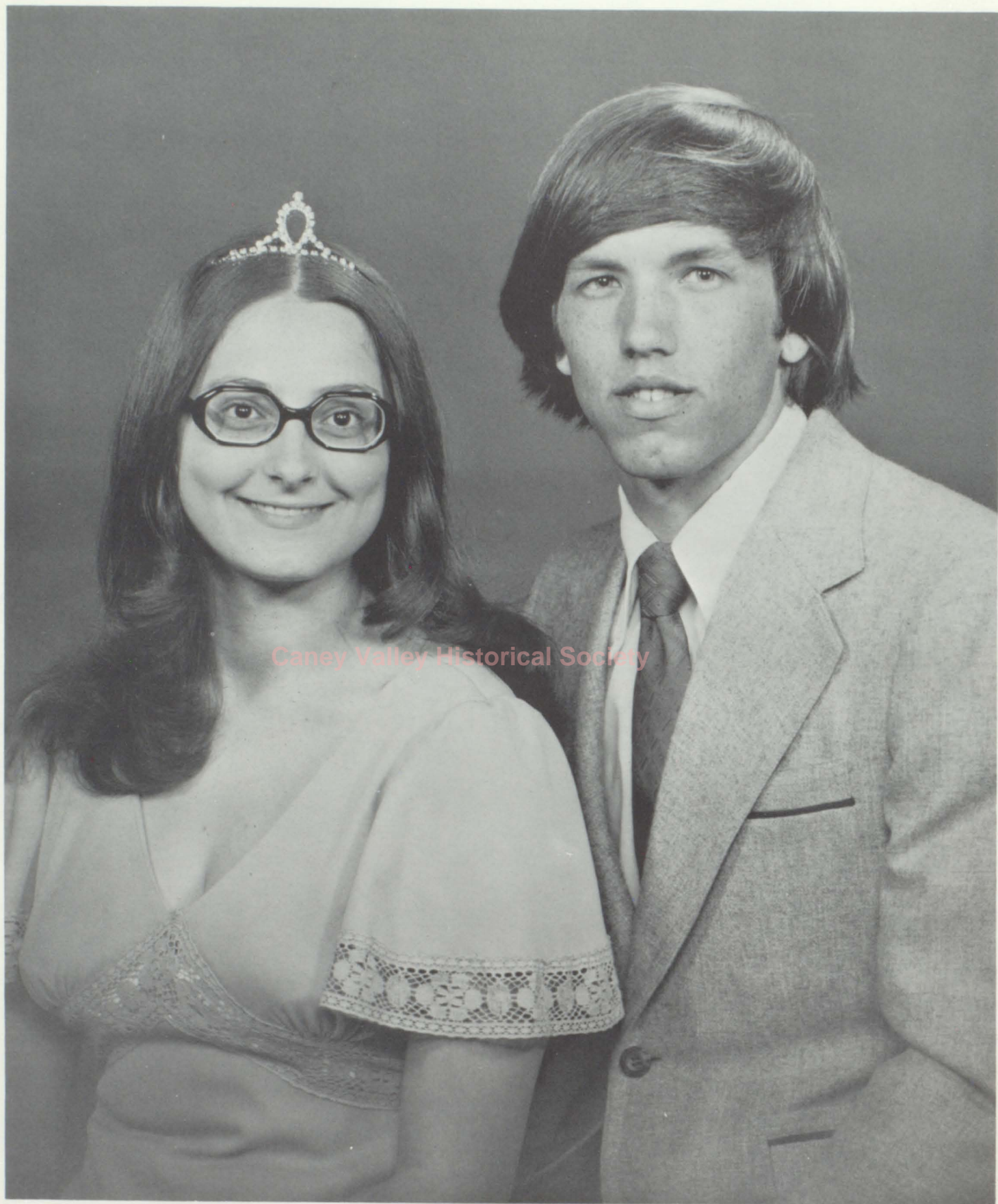

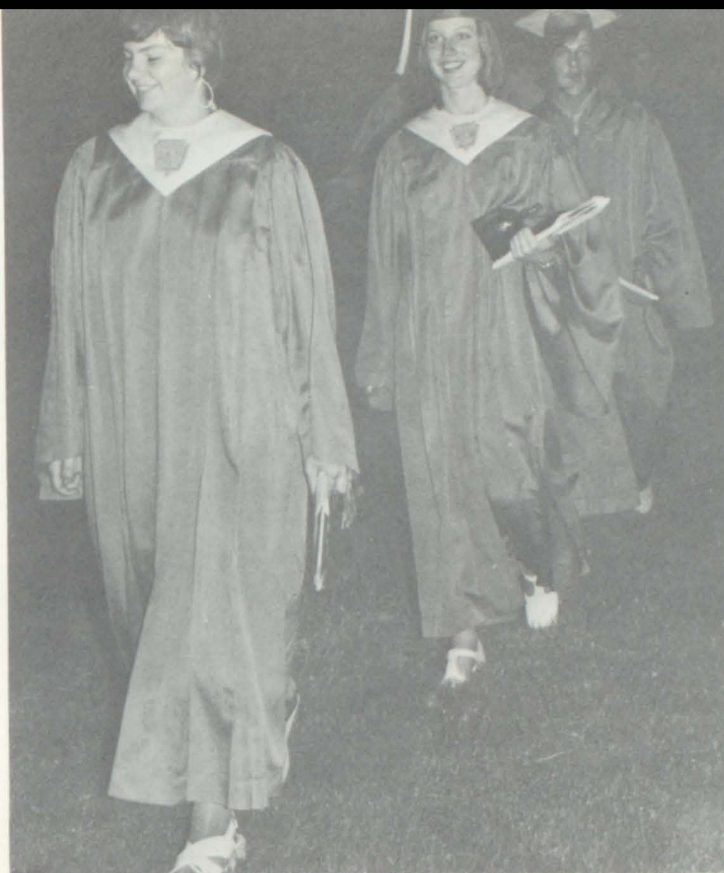

Seniors lead Bullpups...

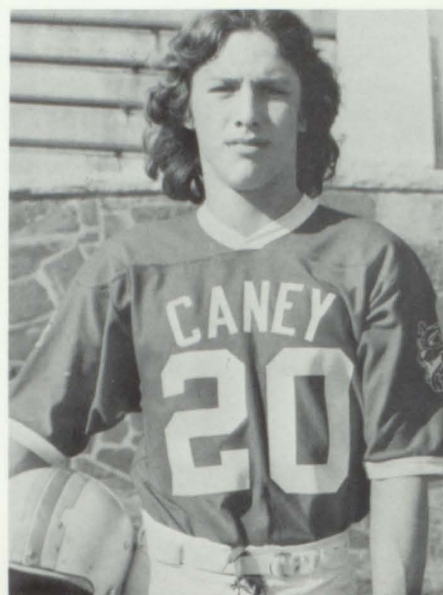

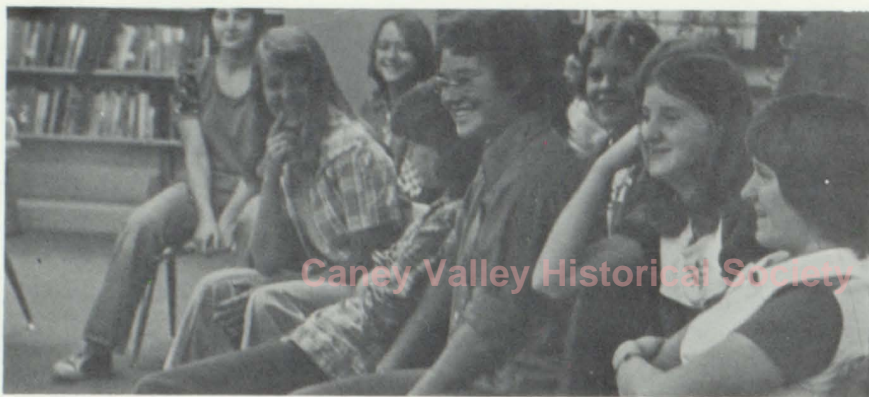
