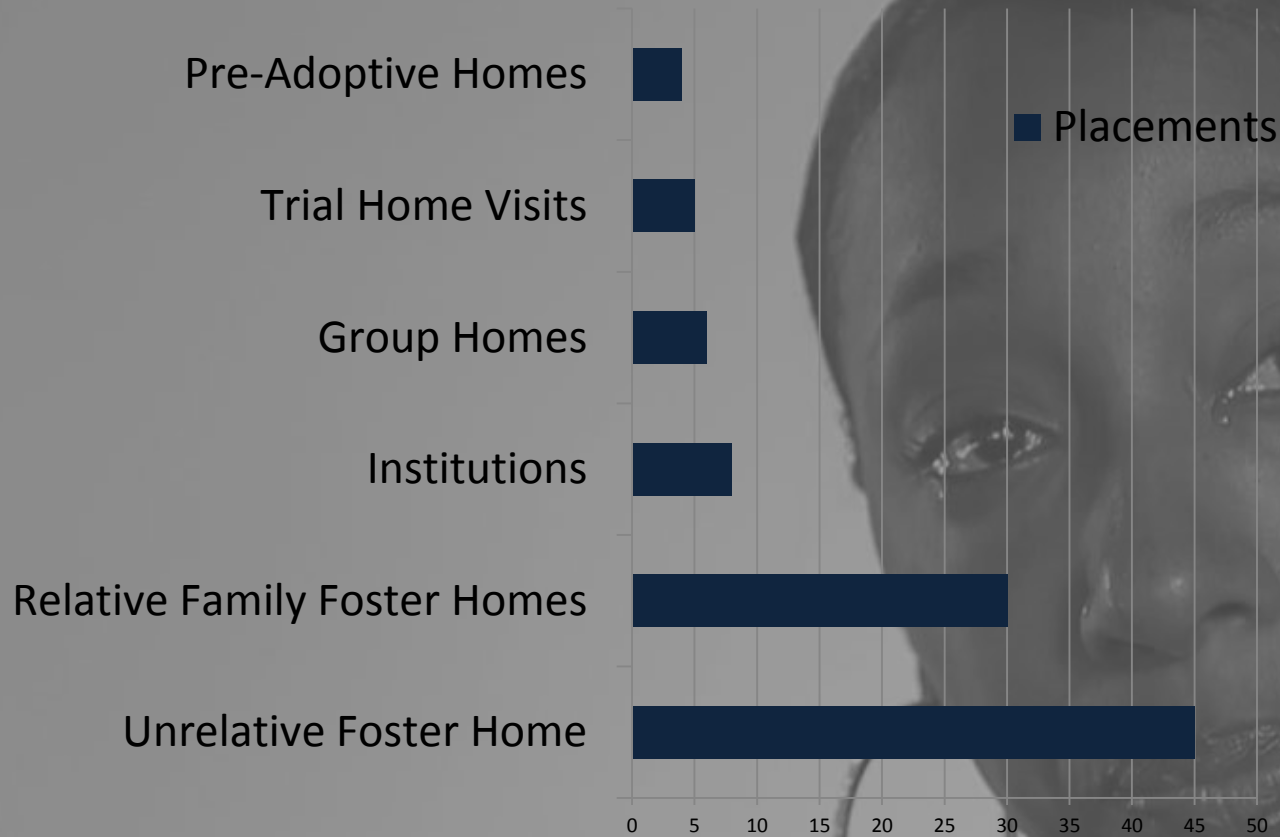

A substitute care for children who are placed away from their parents or guardians, and for whom the State agency has placement and care responsibility.

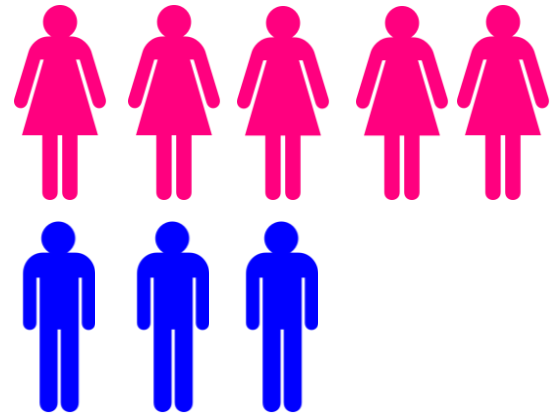
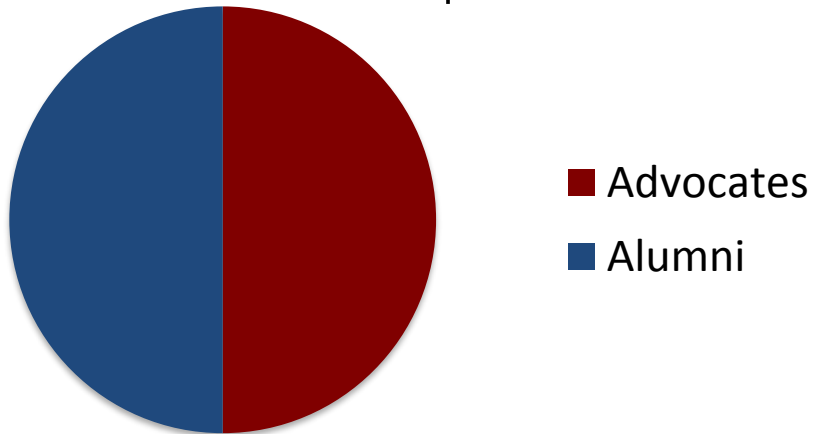
