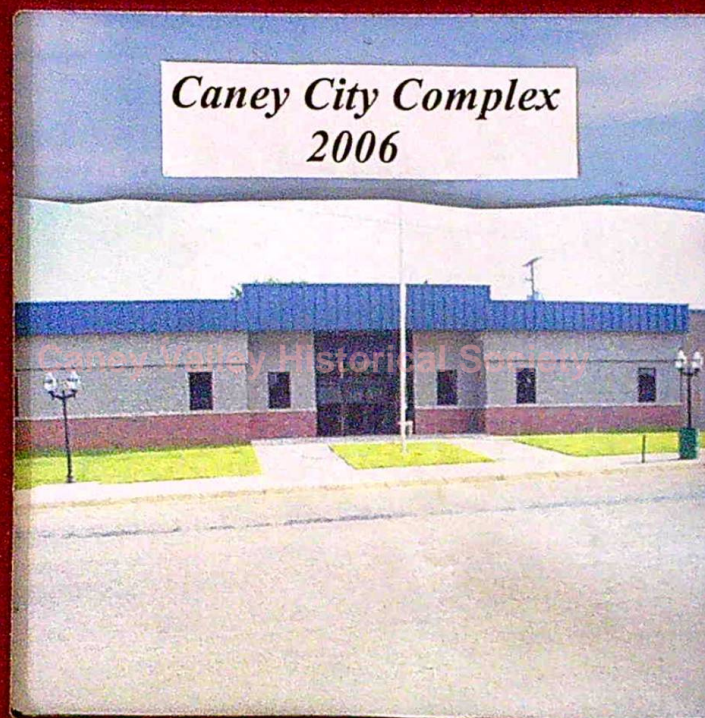

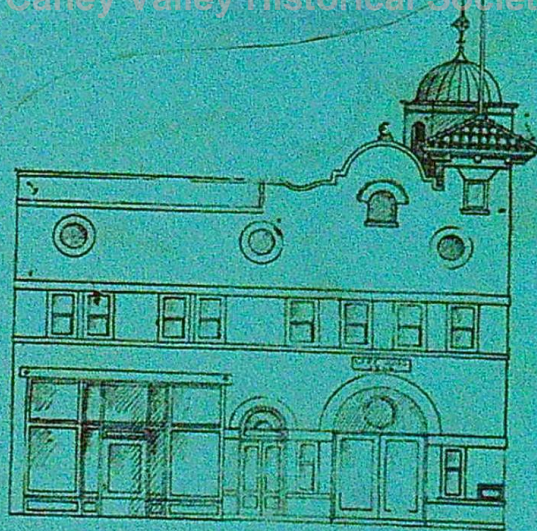
THE NEW CANEY CITY COMPLEX

The City of Caney, Ks., having approximately 250 population was incorporated as a 3rd class city July 5, 1887. The first official election of city officials was called at the Little White School House, July 18, 1887.

The People's Party won electing H.P. Hollingsworth, Mayor, and council members, William Rogers, Harry P. Wiltse, J.J. Hemphill, J.A. Summer, and W.B. McWilliams. Also, F.H. Hooker, Judge and D.K. Mitchell as Treasurer.

No permanent facilities for Caney City Hall were available so they met thereafter at the Little White School House for a period of time. Old city maps show the location of city hall at many different locations over the years. However, in 1905 Mayor Charles Wilson, had the vision for a new Caney City Hall, but it was not to be. The local Caney News was supportive and published in Feb. 24, 1905 the following picture:
