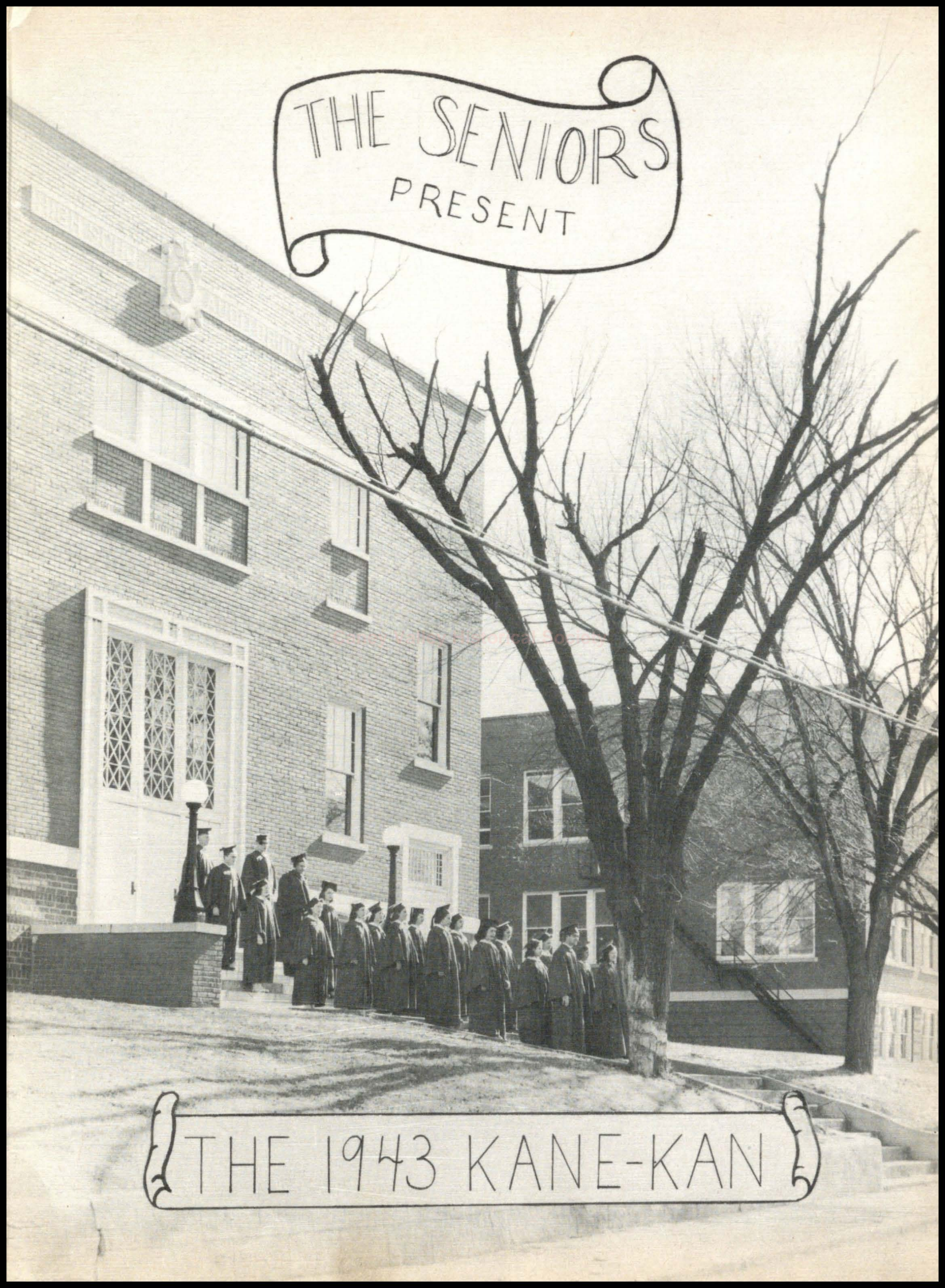

CHIEF TRIBAL HISTORY

IN 1939, SIXTY-SIX INDIANS ENTERED THE "BIG WIGWAM" AS FRESHMEN. THE OFFICERS ELECTED WERE STEVE WILSON-PRESIDENT, LOWELL WOOLF-VICE-PRESIDENT, BETTY WEMMER-SECRETARY-TREASURER, WITH MARGARET LAMBDIN AND CARL SODEN AS GUIDES.

1940 LEFT SIXTY-FOUR BRAVES AND SQUAWS TO WEATHER THE SOPHOMORE CLASS. THE OFFICERS WERE LOWELL WOOLF-PRESIDENT, JOHNNIE SURRETT-VICE-PRESIDENT, BETTY WEMMER-SECRETARY, MARTHA HILDEBRANT-TREASURER.

OUR RESPONSIBILITIES DOUBLED DURING OUR JUNIOR YEAR WHICH CREATED DEMAND FOR MORE WAMPUM. A CHILLI SUPPER AND ICE CREAM SOCIAL MADE POSSIBLE THE GREAT HI-LIGHT OF THE YEAR, THE BIG POW-WOW HELD FOR THE SENIORS, WITH THE ATMOSPHERE OF A MINIATURE RESERVATION. OUR TRIBE WAS ALSO REPRESENTED IN THE ANNUAL JR.-SR. PRODUCTION, "MAN OR MOUSE."

WE, AS SENIORS OF 1943, ARE ABOUT TO DESCEND UPON THE LAND OF PLENTY. STILL REIGNING AS HIGH CHIEFTAIN IS LOWELL WOOLF, WITH SHIRLEY McNICHOL, HILDE SCIMECA, AND DONALDEEN KELLER ASSISTING. OUR MOST CAPABLE SPONSORS ARE MARGARET LAMBDIN AND RUTH HORTON.

OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS HAVE BEEN MANY, AND MAY THE LEGEND OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF '43 BE REMEMBERED BY THE ON-COMING CLASSES OF CANEY HIGH SCHOOL.

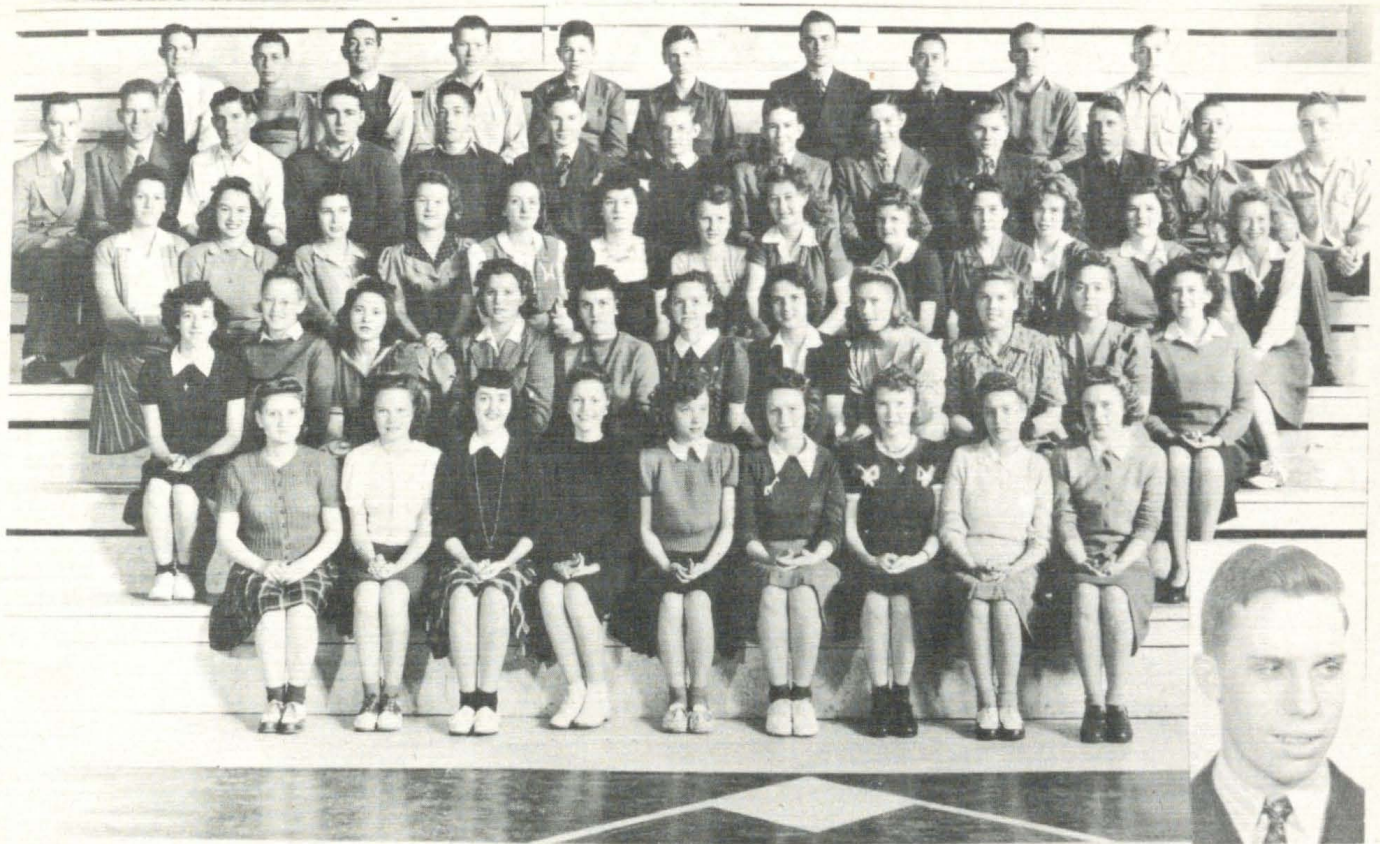
