Another Judge Assigned For Library Case

Judge Jess Miracle of Okemah now is assigned to preside over a suit filed by Miss Ruth W. Brown, discharged city librarian, asking that she be reinstated.

Previously Judge H. D. Ballaine of Pawnee was scheduled to hear the suit, filed against city library board, and others.

District Judge James T. Shipman of Bartlesville, claiming he is an interested party in the suit, disqualified himself on Oct. 2 and shortly afterward Chief Justice Denver N. Davison of Oklahoma supreme court appointed Judge Ballaine to preside.

Friday Chief Justice Davison notified Court Clerk Robert E. Lee that the order appointing Judge Ballaine had been vacated and that Judge Miracle has been assigned here to preside over the suit on Nov. 9 and 10.
