Senate: On Wherry amendment to supple-mental appropriations bill to provide for a flat

mental appropriations bill to provide for a flat ban on economic aid to nations which trade in war materials with Russia, defeated 39-28: Kerr and Thomas voted against. On passage over president's veto, 57-10, of communist control bill (two-thirds majority required): Kerr and Thomas NOT voting.

House: On final passage, 328-7 of \$4,508,000,-000 emergency tax increase bill: all FOR except Gilmer (D) NOT voting. On passage over president's veto 286-43, of communist control bill (two-thirds majority required): Albert, Monroney, Steed, Wickersham and Wilson (all Democrats) FOR: Morris (D) against; Gilmer and Stigler (both Democrats) NOT voting.
