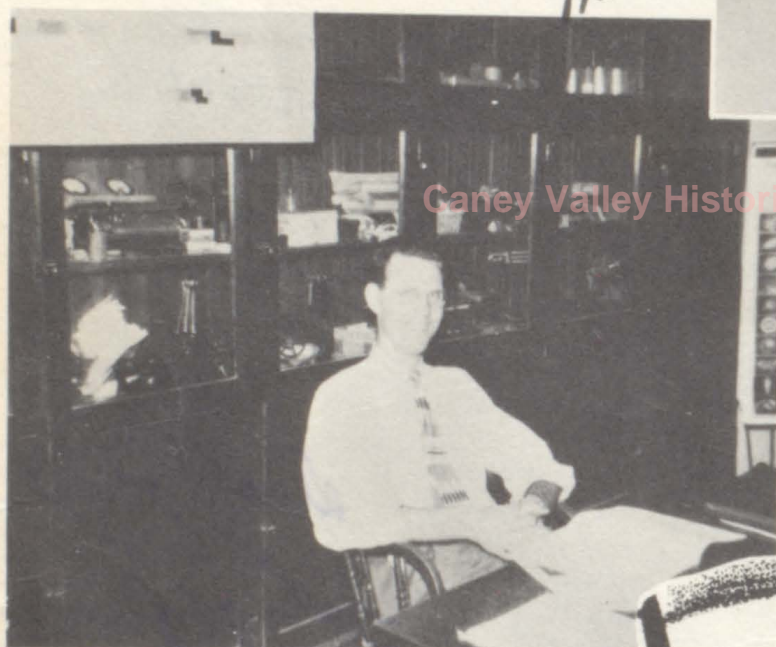

Class History

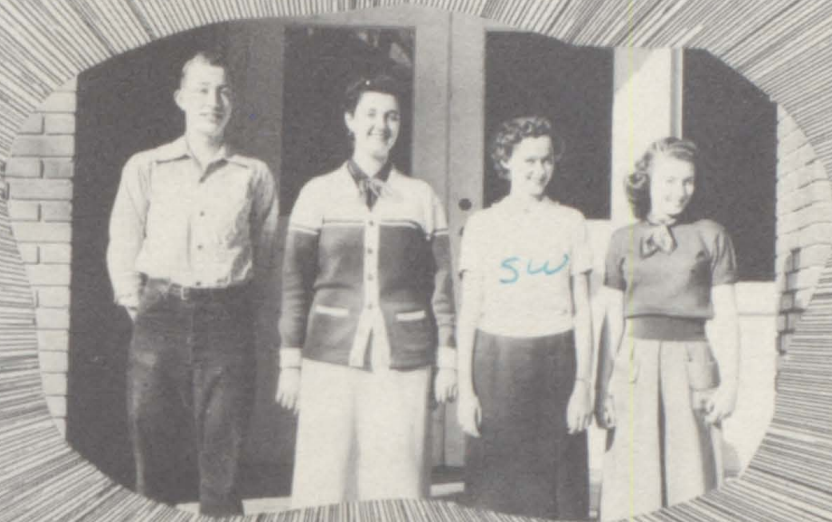
