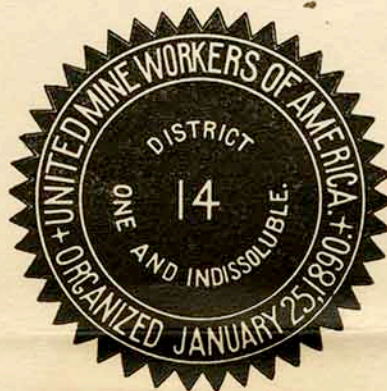

The following Retail Stores, Pittsburg, Kansas,
remain unfair to Organized Labor:

Kress' Store,
Woolsworth's Store,
Mummeys' Store,
Penny's Store,
Ramsay's Store,
Seymour's Store,
Newman's Store,
Stewart's Store.

The efforts of your Officials to assist in
negotiating a contract, have been met by the managers
of the above named stores with absolute refusals.

We have the following suggestions to make:

First: That a bulletin of these stores be
placed at the pit head, so that all members may see it.

Second: That where your Local Union is work-
ing, and you are in a financial position to do so, that
you select one of your idle members to do picket duty in
Pittsburg, which will aid the local organizations, both
by the picket duty, and will enable our organization to
know whether any members of our organization or their
families are trading in these stores.

This is not only a fight against the Retail
Clerks' Union, but a fight against organized labor in
general, and should be dealt with accordingly.
