**New Library Board Named

City commissioners appointed a new six-man board to take over the direction of the Bartlesville Public Library at their meeting Monday night at Civic Center.

Under a new ordinance, part of the board is appointed for one year terms and part for two year terms. Those who were named for the one year terms are George Cohrs, Don Koppel

Mayor E. S. Dunaway explained that the board terms were set up to eliminate appointment of a completely new board at one time. He explained that the commissioners felt that, since those who have been serving on the board are all filling out unexpired terms, it would be better to appoint all new

Other business taken up by the commissioners included giving the authority to the city manager to advertise for bids on steel fencing for the west side of the spillway at Lake Hudson.
