## Rain, Slush The Band Marches On

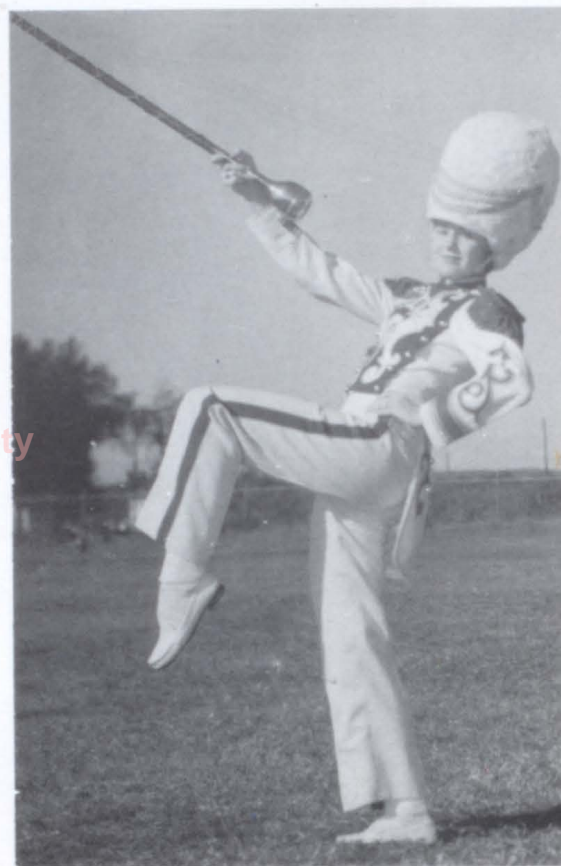

Miss Donna Richardson heads the band as drum majorette. Donna is a junior and has done the band justice in her first year.

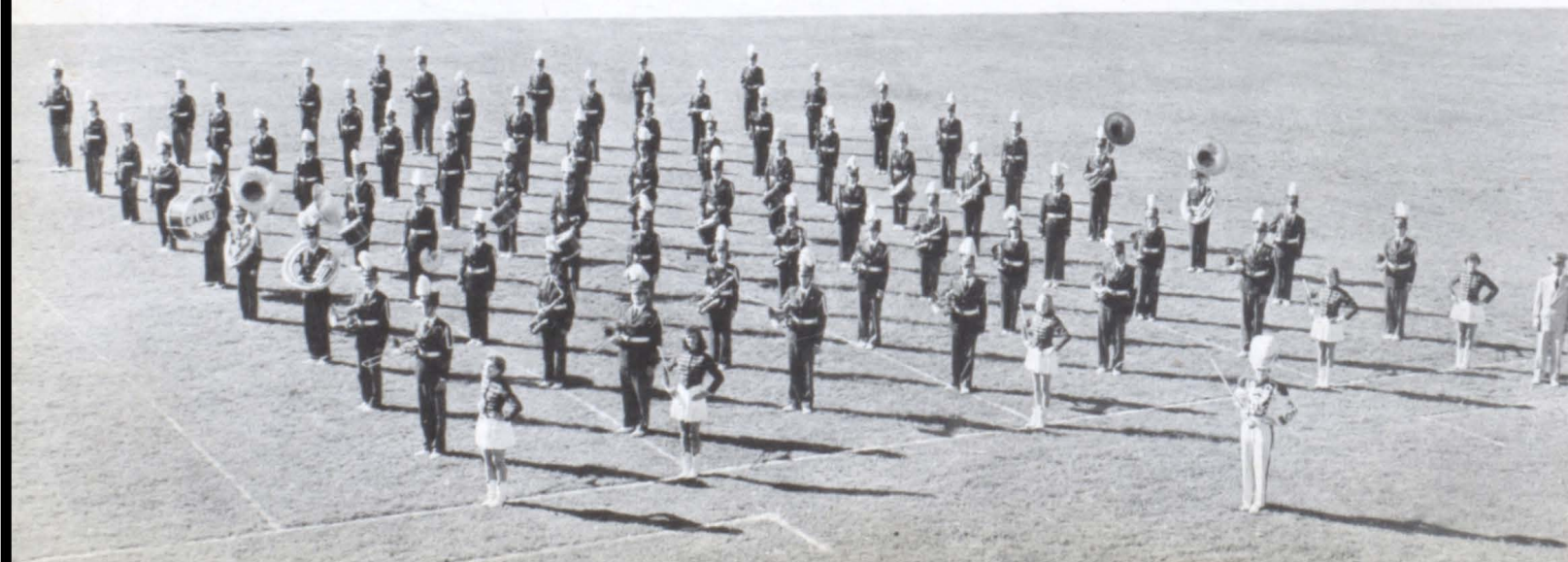

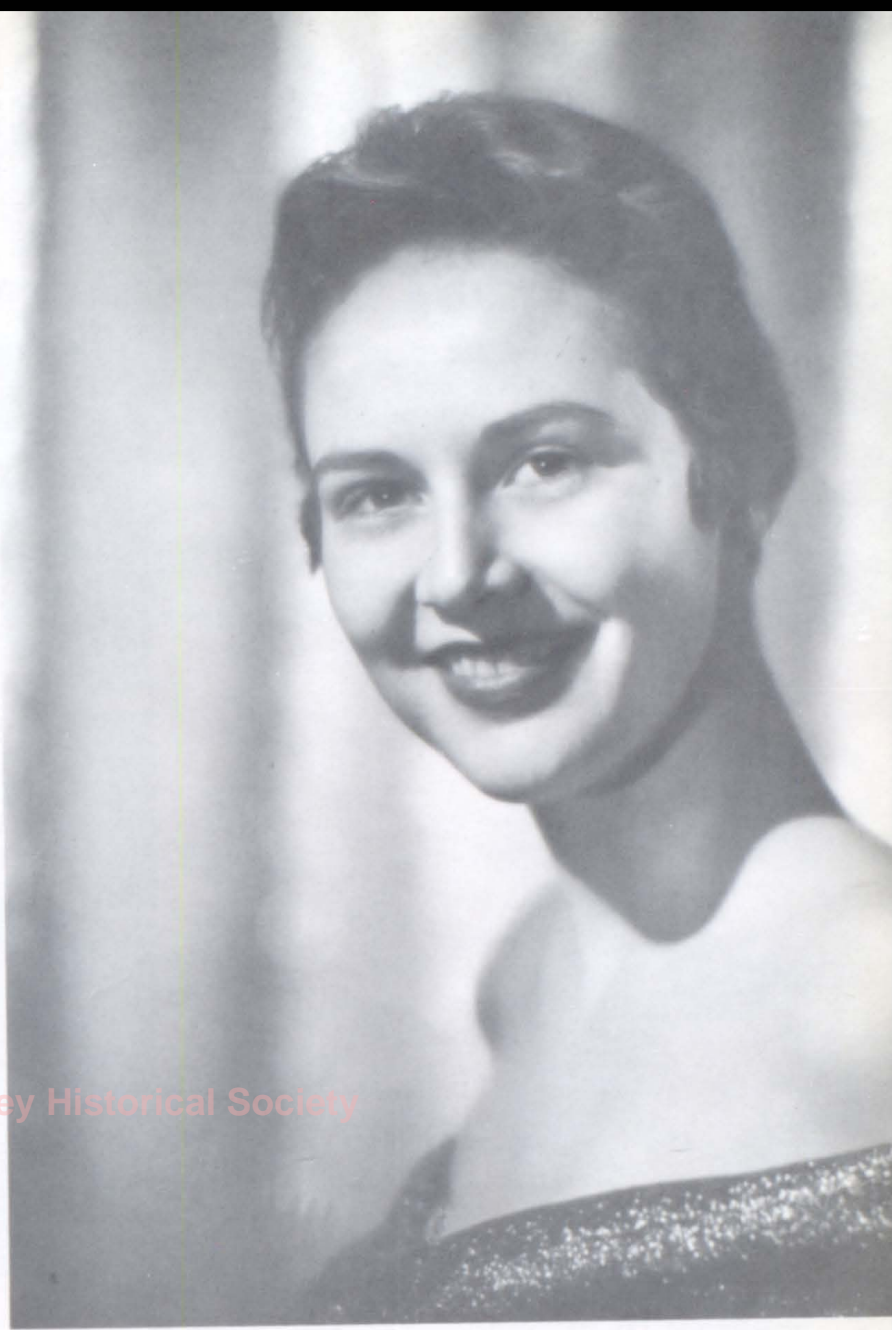




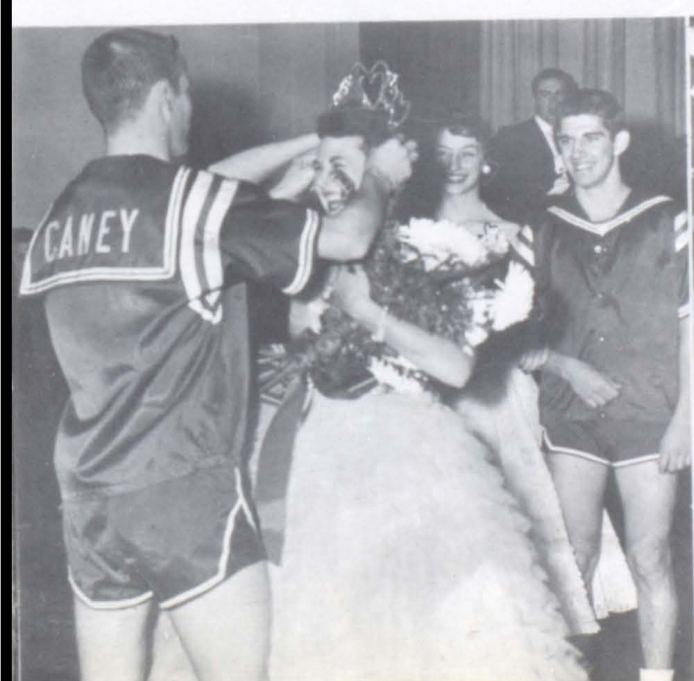
The 1957-1958 "Queen of the Court" was Miss Darla Boles. Darla is a junior in Caney High School.
