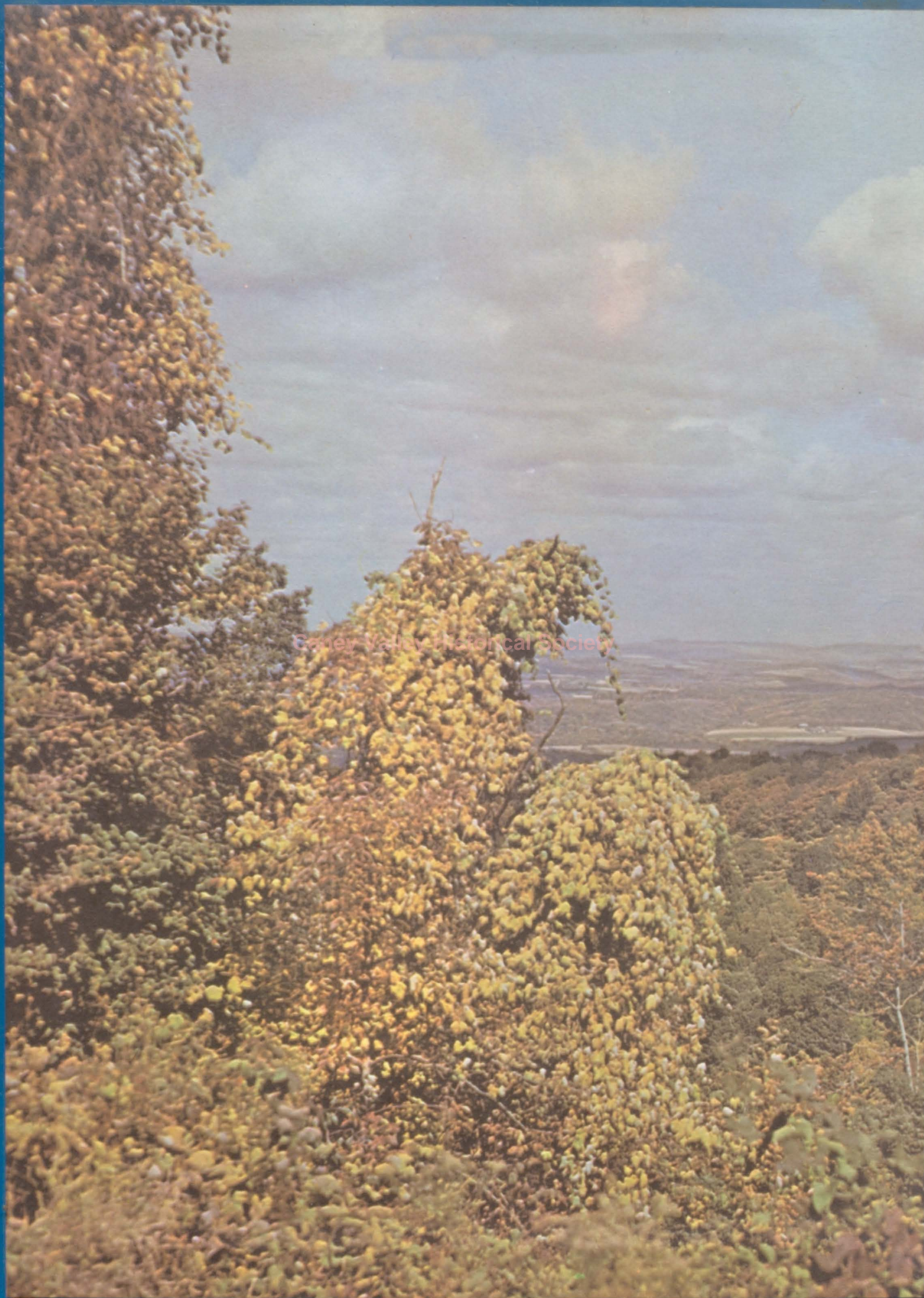

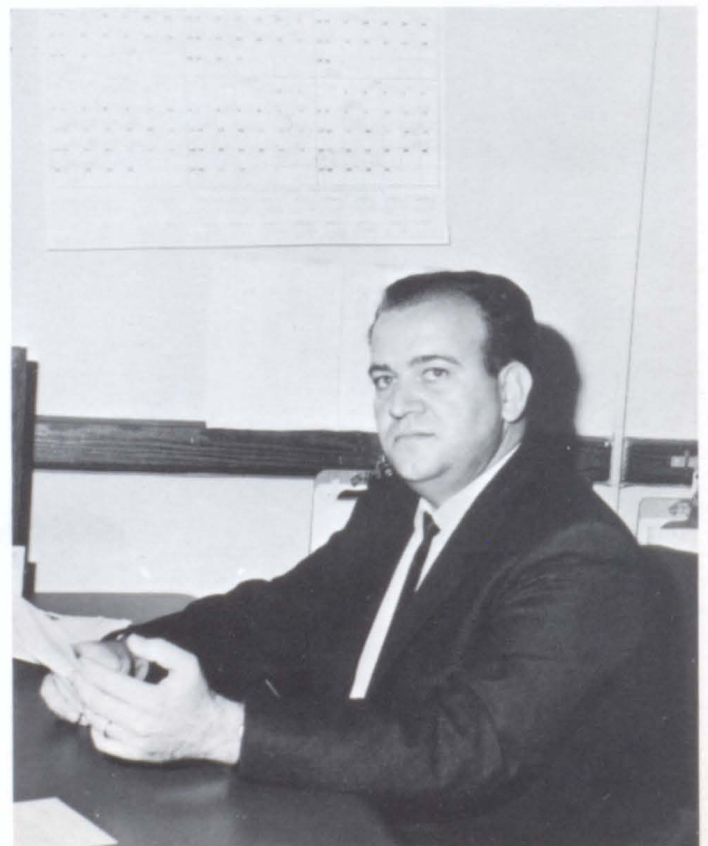
KENNETH I. RITCHEY

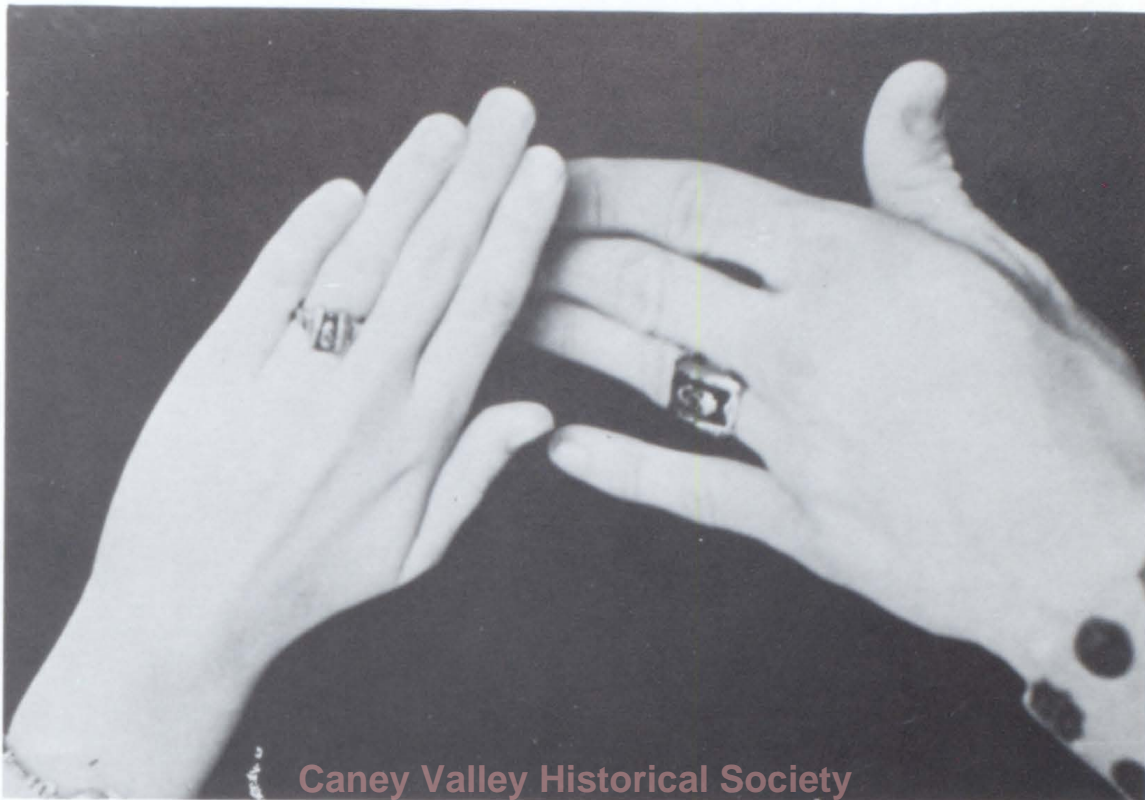

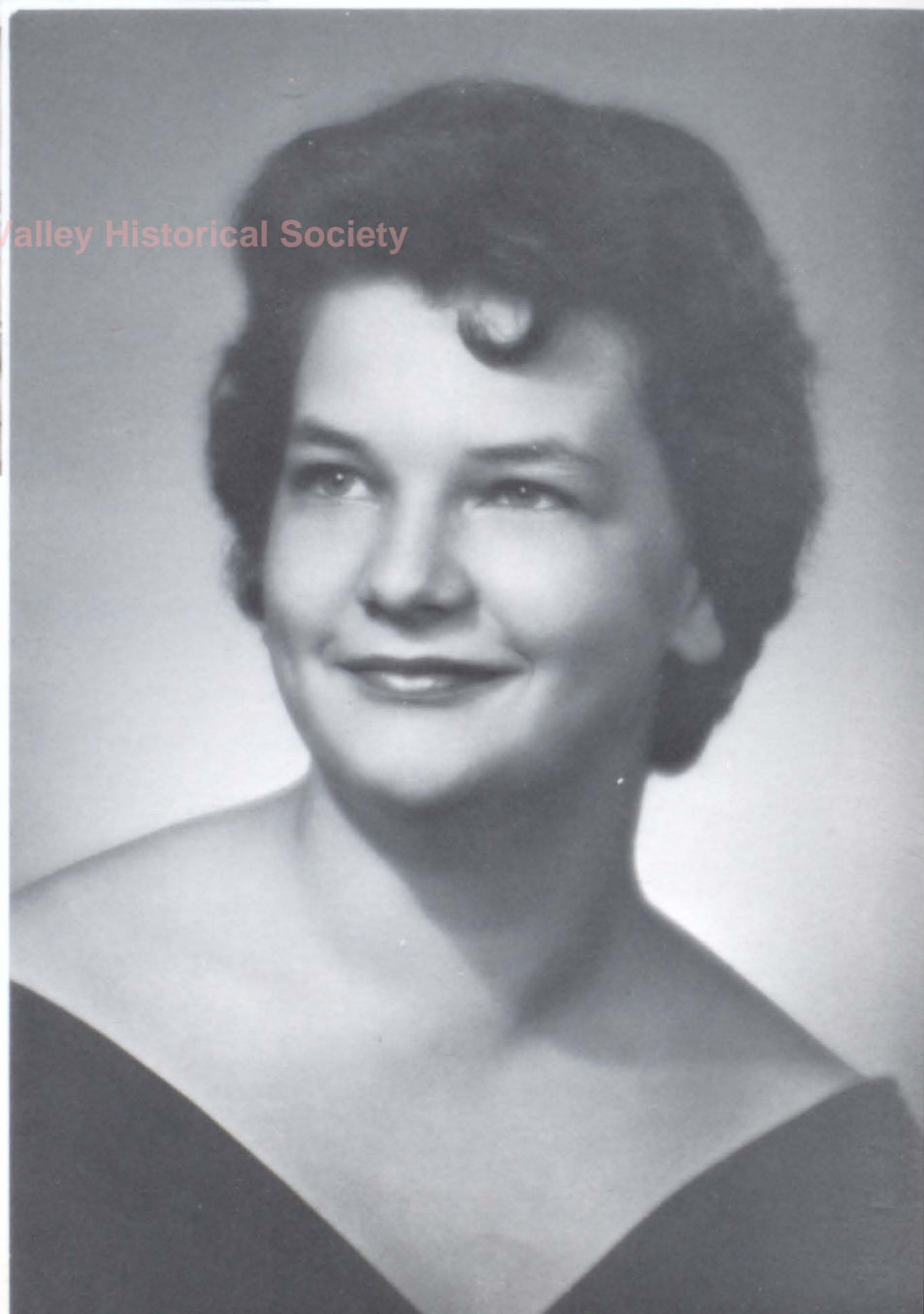
Senior Farewell
