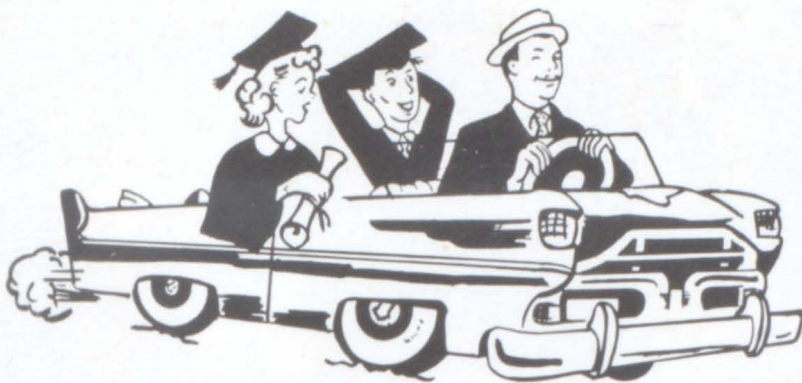

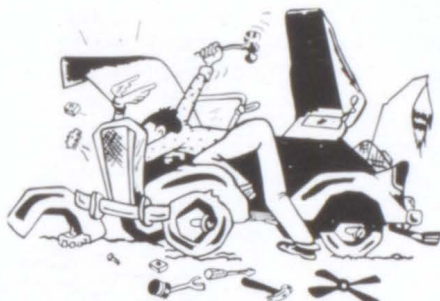

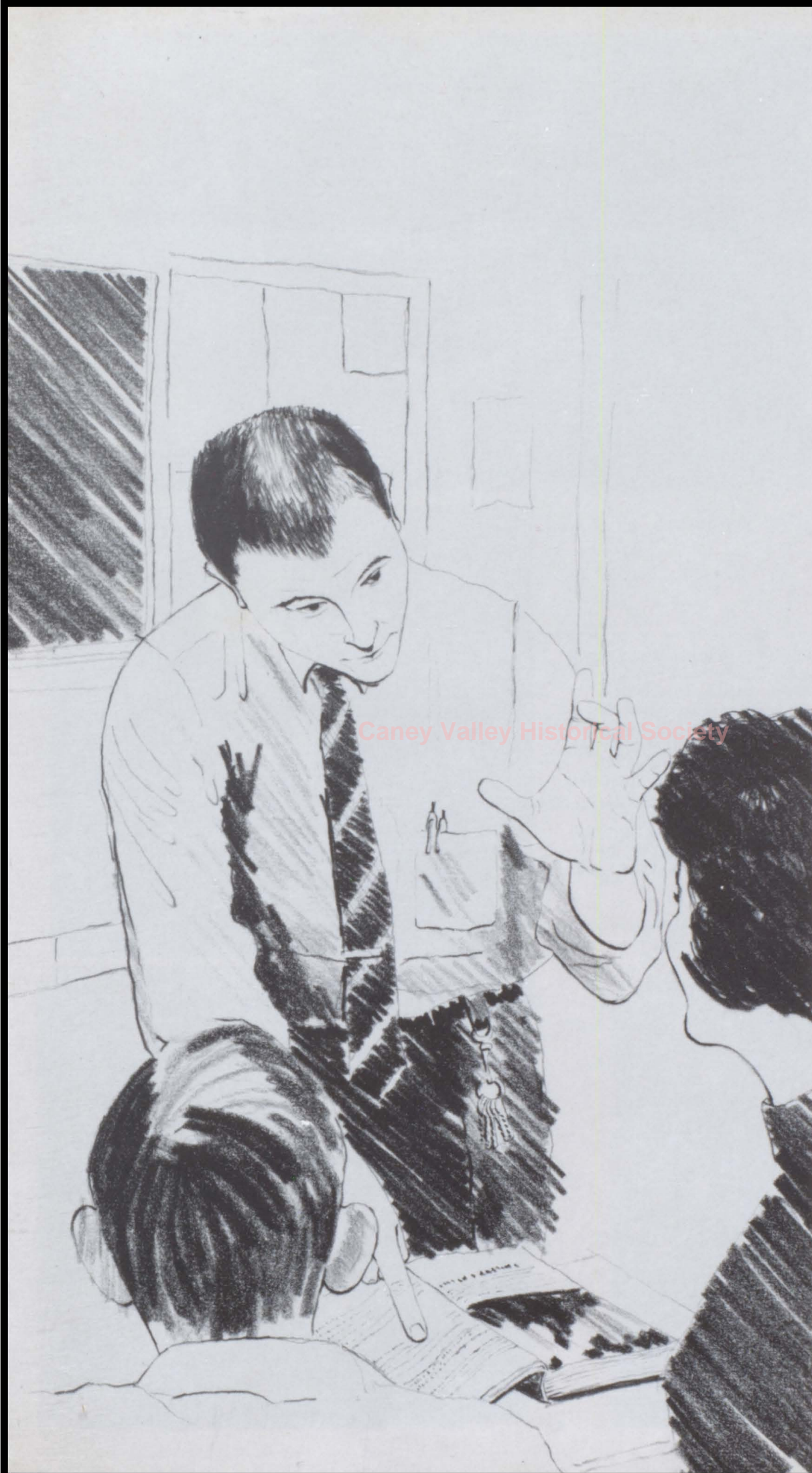
STUDENT COUNCIL

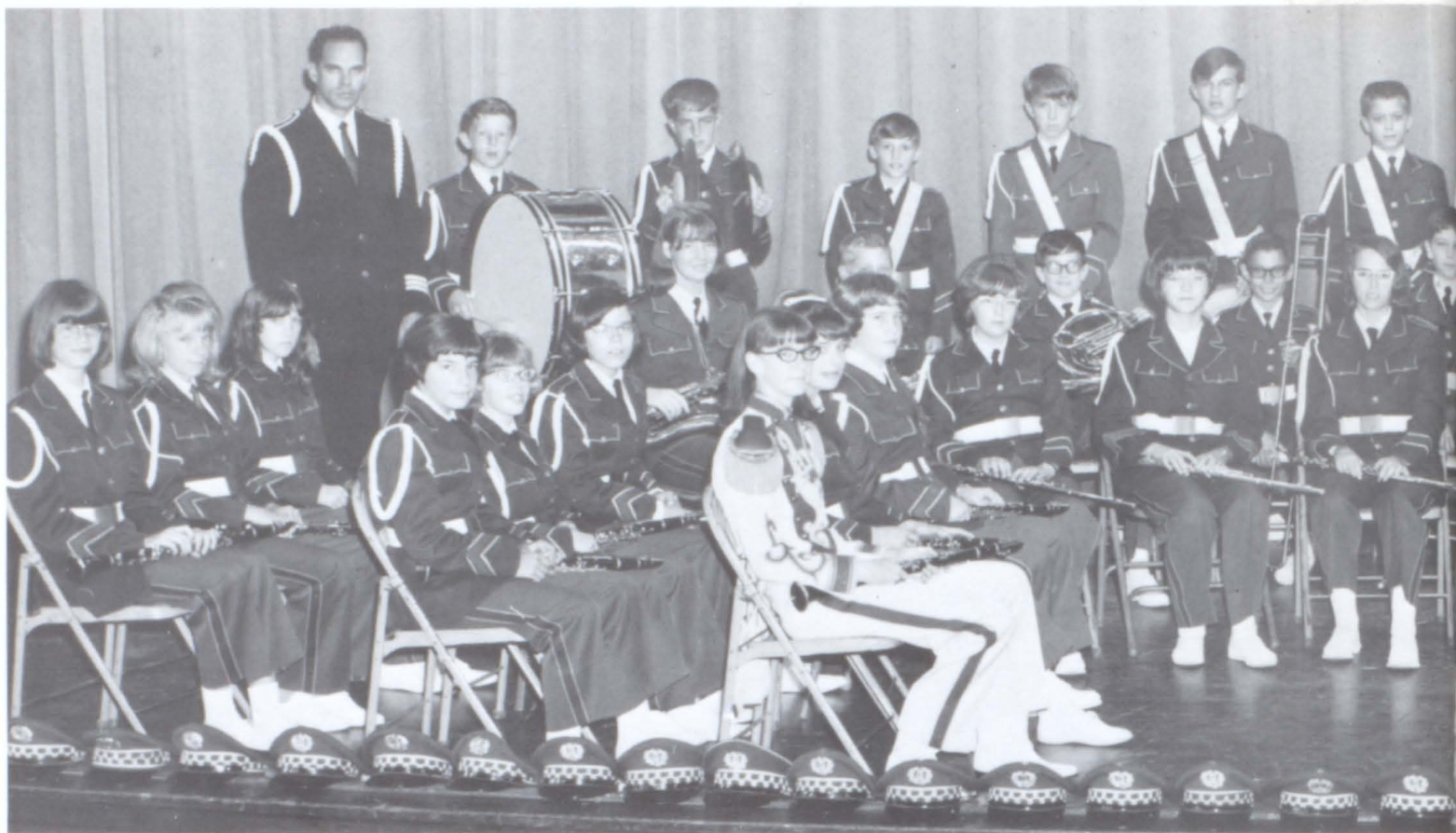
There are basically two types of madrigals, Italian and English. The Italian madrigal has Romantic characteristics. The English madrigal tended to be light but still retained a certain charm.
