Firsts . . .

- Aug., 1903.....Normal School at Pittsburg was first normal
Manual Training School in U. S.
- Aug. 4, 1903.....First bulletin concerning school was issued.
- Sept. 8, 1903.....First day of school at the State Normal Training
School. Presside Chandler was first student to
enroll.
- Sept. 25, 1903.....First school color was chosen as Crimson.
- Oct. 17, 1903.....First Porterian and Manus Verez literary societies
were organized.
- Dec. 5, 1903.....First normal school yell chosen.
- Jan. 23, 1904.....First normal school song selected.
- April 22, 1905.....Normal orchestra made its first appearance.
- March, 1907.....Mr. Russ first fined a barrel of apples.
- March 1, 1907.....Bill providing for free kindergarten in public
schools.
- Sept. 22, 1907.....Athletic association organized.
- March 6, 1908.....Faculty fined barrel of apples.
- Sept. 1, 1908.....First Homemaker's course offered.
- Dec. 18, 1908.....State Manual Training Normal moved to new
administration building.
- Oct. 2, 1908.....First football team formed.
First football game with Pittsburg High School
- Sept., 1909.....Music department added to Normal school.
- Oct. 25, 1909.....Normal band organized with 18 members.
- Feb. 21, 1910.....First intercollegiate basketball game.
- April 30, 1910.....First Inter-State contest.
- May 16, 1910.....Y. W. organized with 36 members.
- June, 1910.....School paper was established.
