1970 Varsity Basketball

For the second season in a row, Caney was one of the feared names among SEKan high school basketball teams. With a patterned offense and a man-to-man defense, the Caney squad went to a 13-8 winning season, tutored all the way by Coach Jim Kerwin, a former Tulane and Phillips 66 star.

Against all predictions of defeat, the Coach propelled the team to victory after victory, overcoming losses by use of team spirit and work again and again. At the first of the season, the Coach evolved the theory that the squad's lack of height over 6'3" was not a disadvantage, but that it made the asset of a quick team, capable of handling the "roundball" expertly, and to much acclaim.

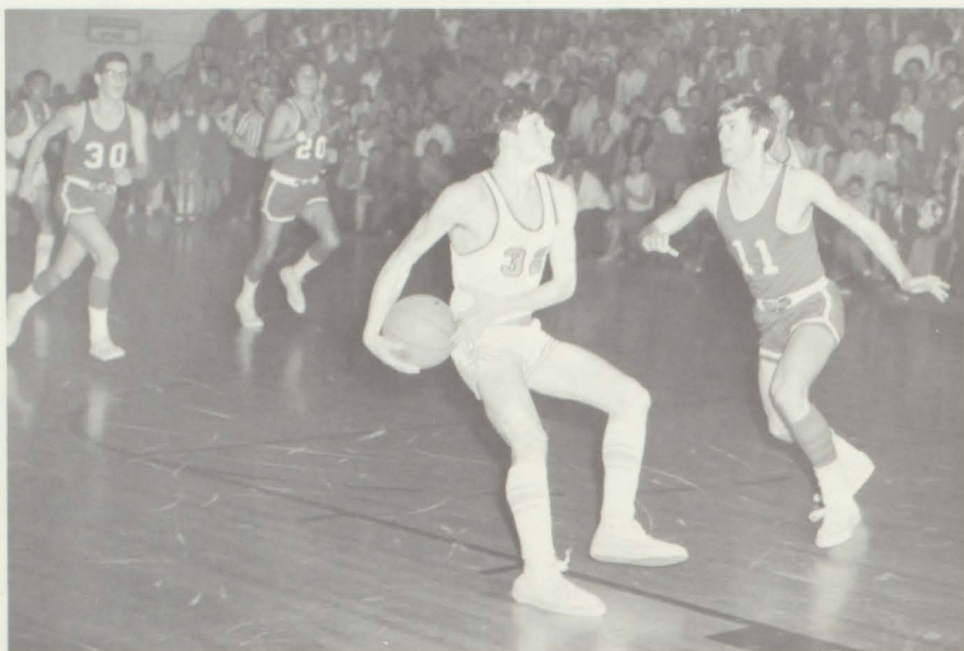
By team effort, the squad came from behind to win many times, always playing in the manner prescribed by the coach. When more points were called for by the bench, play was speeded up, with quick searches for holes in the opposing defense. When a weakness was found, shots would be taken, utilizing the lax opposition and the ability of the team to shoot field goals. With well over 900 of the 1294 total points amassed by the team in field goals, the games presented were very exciting and many times, high-scoring. Also, most of the points were delivered under pressure from the bench.

Making the best of two of the superb players Caney has produced in all its years as a school, the coach fired the team with the outside shots and excellent defense of John Burch and Gene Wilson. Pouring forth baskets with all the surety of "death and taxes," these two players, one a guard and the other a forward, foiled many of their opponents attempts for two points. Sparking the team was one of the many primary abilities of both the players, which caused dependence upon them in a game situation. This dependence was very noticeable whenever one or both players were absent from a game, whether by injury or to provide experience for substitutes.

By no means, however, were John and Gene the only focal points of the team. In many games, the deficiency of height in the squad was overcome by the guts in rebounding of the team. The forwards and centers were always pushed by the coach to scramble and "check" off the "boards" and were chastised if they did not. This continual critique brought about practice which stressed free throws, rebounding, ball handling, and plays to be used in a game. In this way, the coach molded the individuals into the 1969-70 Caney squad, those who worked together, pressing on for a victory until the last buzzer sounded.

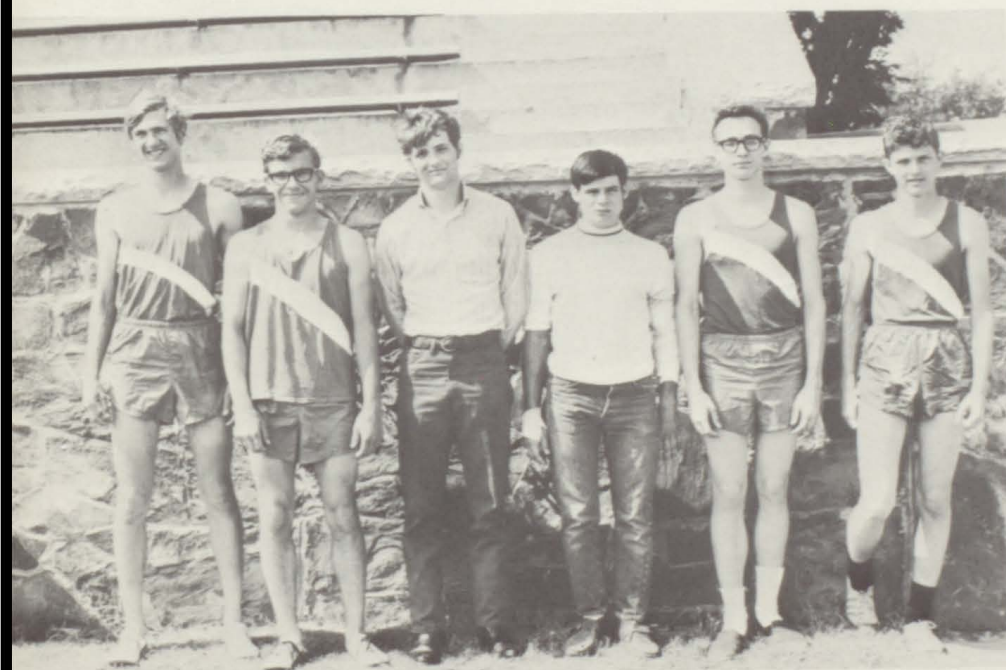

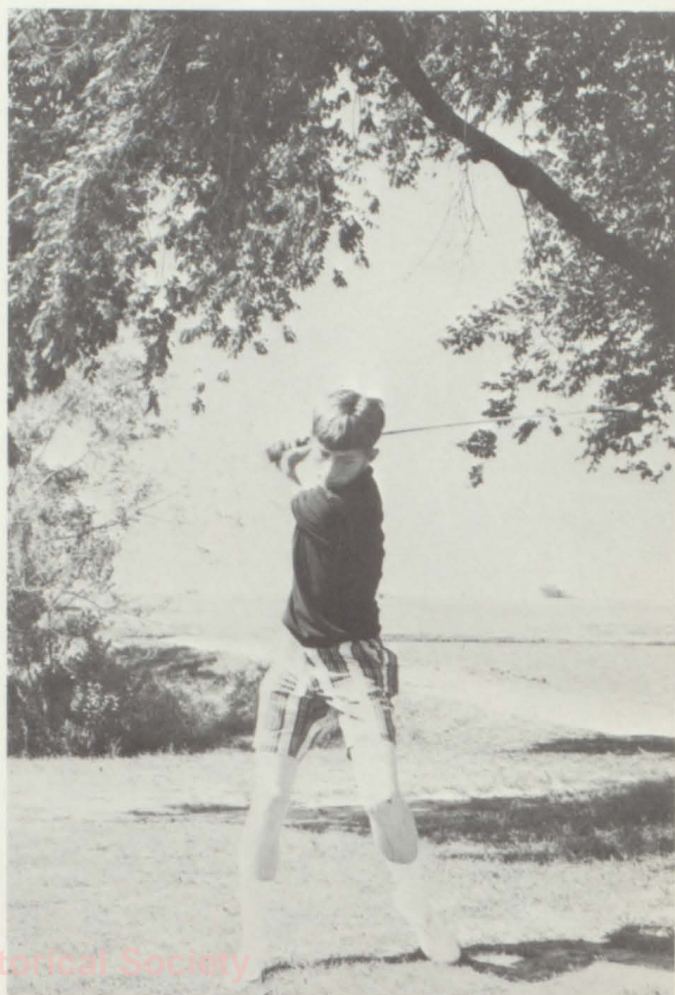
Lon broke the CHS cross country record which he set at 10:30 minutes. He holds the Iola mile steeple chase record at 5.008 minutes.

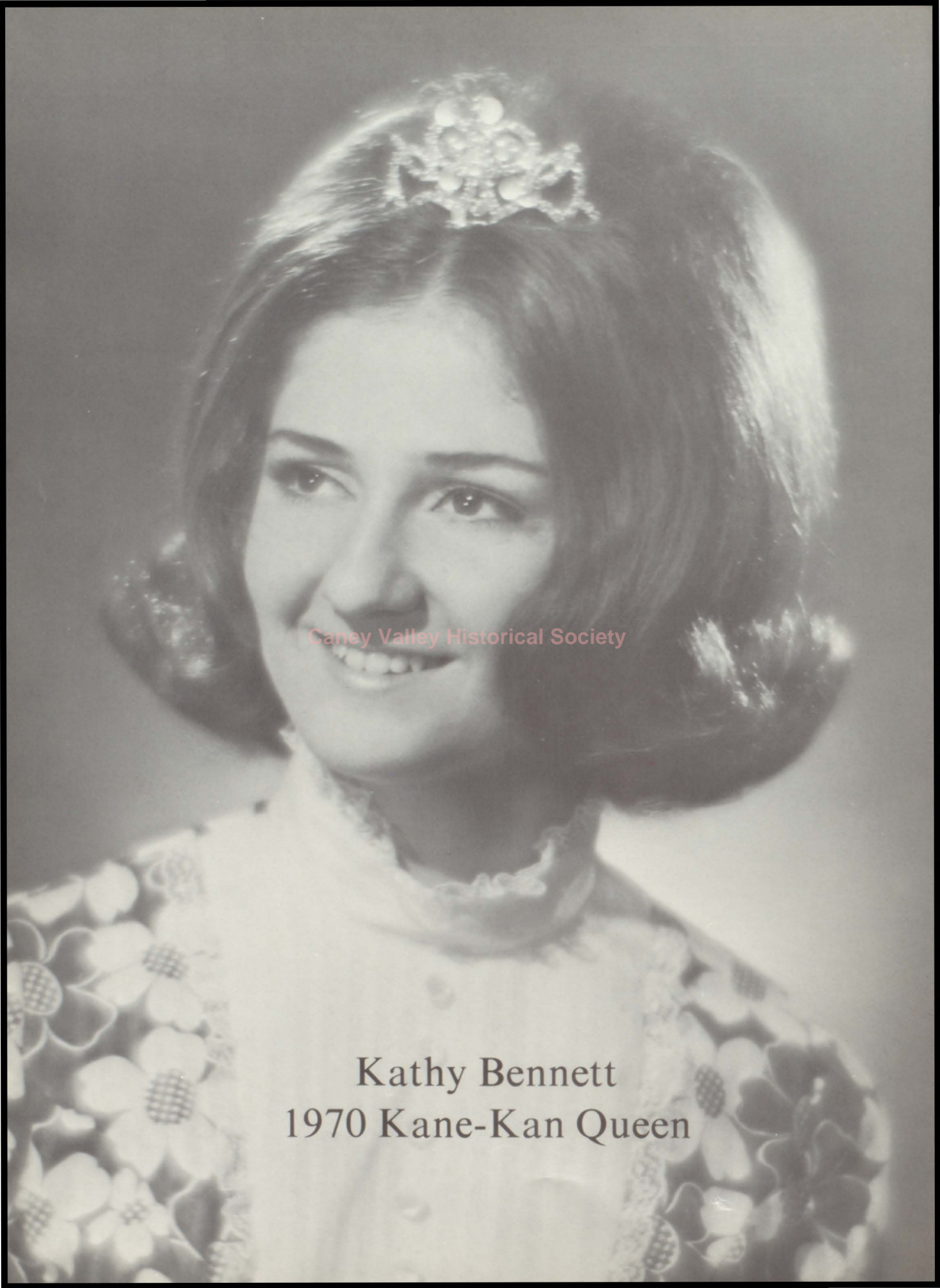
With Editor Martin Owen at the helm, the Kane-Kan organizational ship sailed over rather rough waters in a dignified manner.

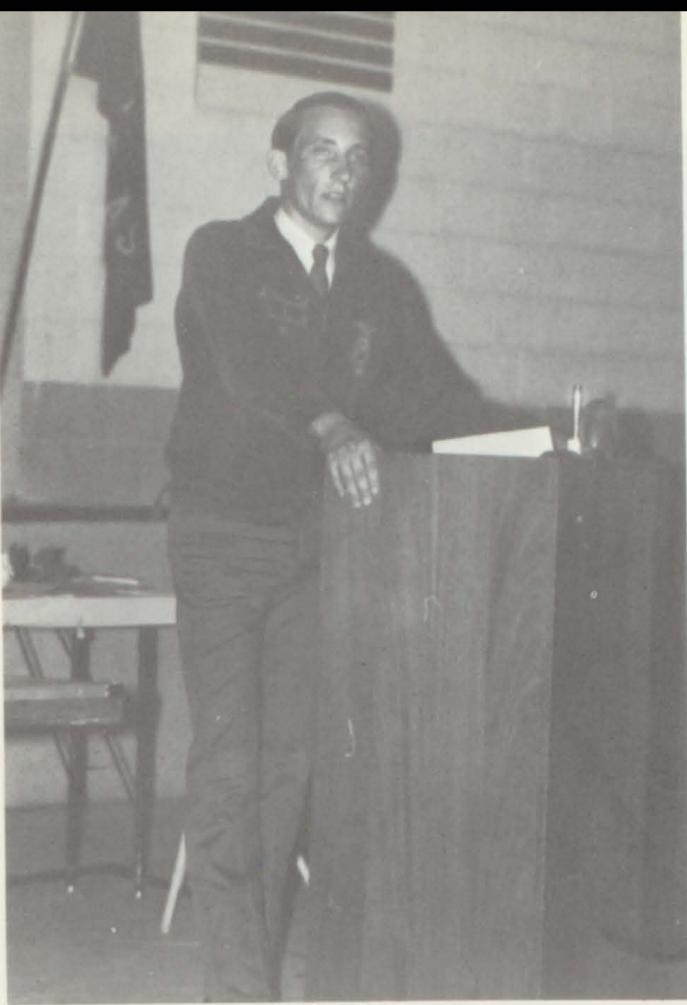
