Schick is an internationally-recognized artist whose work has been exhibited in museums around the world and has been featured in many national and international books and magazines. In 2000, she was named a Fellow of the American Craft Council, one of the highest awards given to craft artists in the United States. Just over 150 artists have earned the distinction to date. In 2002, she received the Kansas Governor's Artist Award in recognition of her career as an artist. Schick has been a member of the PSU faculty since 1967. She was named a "University Professor" in 2000, an honor reserved for a select group of PSU faculty who demonstrate excellence in teaching, research, creative endeavors or community service.



The Pittsburg State University Seal

The Pittsburg State University Seal, redesigned in 1994, reflects the mission of instruction, research and service and also symbolizes the history, traditions, and future of the University. The first circle from the outside represents the University's future. The second circle identifies the University's name; the wheat sheafs symbolize the State of Kansas. The third circle includes the initials and dates for the previous names of the institution and identifies the mission of Pittsburg State University. The fourth circle contains an etching of the front entrance to Russ Hall with its four columns, the symbolic image of the University.

Change and progress give evidence of the dynamic development of Pittsburg State University from the founding of the State Manual Training Normal School in 1903 to the recognition in 1923 of the transformation of SMTN to Kansas State Teachers College, a comprehensive college educating teachers for the nation's elementary and secondary schools. From the very beginning, some graduates pursued careers in professional areas allied to their teaching degree. In 1959, KSTC became Kansas State College at Pittsburg, which recognized the expanded mission to educate students in the arts and sciences and in business, education, and technical fields for various professions and careers. In 1977, KSCP became Pittsburg State University to mark the transition from a college to a university with a range of undergraduate majors, graduate programs, and four organized schools in arts and sciences, business, education, and technology. The University embraced a common bond with all universities to pursue instruction, research and service.

One constant in the ten decades of Pittsburg State University is Russ Hall. Constructed in 1907 and opened in January 1908, it became the landmark first building that anchored SMTN as a permanent presence in higher education in Pittsburg, the State of Kansas, and the Nation. The doors to Russ Hall have admitted thousands of students during the University's history. Russ Hall forever stands as a tribute to the bold vision of the founders.

Students who are graduating with the Scholastic Honors summa cum laude, magna cum laude or cum laude are designated by ribbons and medallions worn around the neck. Red ribbon represents summa cum laude; green ribbon represents magna cum laude; white ribbon represents cum laude.

Academic Regalia

Every one possessing a college degree is entitled to wear a black robe on appropriate occasions. Faculty members and candidates for graduate degrees wear hoods in addition to the gown. Hoods are generally black, trimmed with velvet in the color of the subject field, and are lined with the colors of the college or university conferring the degree.

The correct colors to denote various branches of learning have been established by the Intercollegiate Code: Arts and Letters: white; Commerce and Business Administration: sapphire blue; Education: light blue; Fine Arts: brown; Home Economics: maroon; Music: pink; Nursing: apricot; Philosophy: blue; Physical Education: sage green; Psychology: dark crimson; Science: gold-yellow; Social Work: citron; Technology: brown; General Studies: black.

Donna J. Geisler, BSED '73, MS '74

Donna J. Geisler is the Vice President - Central Office Operations for SBC Corporation's Southwest region. She leads a team of 5,000 employees who support the telecommunications network providing telephone service, SBC Yahoo DSL services, high speed business data applications, long distance and 911 service for SBC's customers in Kansas, Missouri, Oklahoma, Arkansas and Texas.

Geisler, who works in Kansas City, Missouri, first joined SBC in 1974 in Topeka, Kansas, and has lived in Kansas, Missouri and Texas during her career. She progressed within SBC through various management levels in engineering, sales, human resources and network operations until assuming her current role as vice president in 1998. In addition to her assignments within the SBC telephone subsidiary, she has also held positions in SBC's Cingular wireless company as well as SBC Corporate assignments.

She has been active in various professional organizations and community organizations such as Big Brothers/Big Sisters, The United Way and the American Heart Association. She was named Outstanding Business Woman by the YWCA and participated in Leadership Topeka and Leadership America. Geisler presently serves Pittsburg State University as a member of the College of Technology Advisory Council and is a past board member for the PSU Alumni Association. She also currently serves on the Board for the School of Engineering at the University of Kansas. She received the PSU Outstanding Alumni Award in 1983. She earned a Bachelor of Science in Education degree with a major in mathematics in 1973 and a Master of Science degree with a major in mathematics in 1974, both from Pittsburg State University.



Donald D. Woolfolk, BSBA '71

Donald D. Woolfolk retired in November 2003 from his role as Deputy Commander of the United States Army Intelligence and Security Command (INSCOM) at Fort Belvoir, Virginia. He was responsible for all counterintelligence and human intelligence operational policy and activity of INSCOM's subordinate commands around the world. This included Army units support of each of the regional combatant commands that make up the Departments of Defense. His responsibilities included exploitation of captured documents and materials from the battlefield in support of the war fighter and the national intelligence community and national decision makers, and linguist support to intelligence operations and army commanders in the field. Woolfolk retired after 31 and one-half years of active duty in the U.S. Army.

He has received numerous military awards during his military career. A few of those honors include the Distinguished Service Medal, Defense Superior Medal, the Legion of Merit, NATO Medal, Joint Service Commendation Medal and the Meritorious Service Medal. Some additional honors include receiving the U.S. Army Intelligence Corps' Knowlton Award and Medallion and serving as a White House Military Social Aide to Presidents Carter and Reagan. He received the PSU Outstanding Alumni Award in 1984.

He earned a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree in 1971 from PSU. As a graduate of PSU's ROTC program, he was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant. He served two years as an Armor officer before moving into Military Intelligence. Woolfolk earned a Master of Science degree in national security studies from Georgetown University and a Master of Science degree in national Defense University in Washington D.C.



Lon D. Kruger, MS 1977

Lon Kruger is the Head Basketball Coach at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. He previously served as head coach in the National Basketball Association for the Atlanta Hawks and as an assistant coach for the New York Knicks. Prior to moving to NBA coaching, Kruger served as head coach at the University of Illinois, the University of Florida, Kansas State University and Pan American University. He also served as Athletics Director at Pan American.

Under his coaching leadership, his collegiate teams have made 11 appearances in the NCAA tournament. He was twice named SEC Coach of the Year while at the University of Florida. He served as an assistant basketball coach to Bob Johnson at PSU while working on a graduate degree.

As an undergraduate, Kruger played basketball at Kansas State University. He was named the Big Eight Player of the Year in 1973 and 1974. He also played on the U.S. All-Star team that toured China

in 1973. After college, he was drafted by the NBA's Atlanta Hawks and major league baseball's St. Louis Cardinals.

Kruger has been involved in various community service programs and projects throughout his career. He was named a PSU Outstanding Alumnus is 1989. He earned a Master of Science degree with a major in physical education in 1977 from PSU. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from K-State in 1975.

The Mace and Medallion

Two symbolic badges of authority, traditional in many European universities and at some of the oldest schools in this nation, are being used in the commencement ceremonies. The University Mace is carried by Dr. Robert K. Ratzlaff, Vice President for Academic Affairs, Professor, Department of History, Pittsburg State University, on Friday, May 14. The University Mace will be carried by Dr. Kenneth K. Bateman, Director of Alumni Relations, Pittsburg State University, on Saturday, May 15. The honor of carrying the University Mace at commencement is given to a faculty member with extensive service at the University. The Presidential Medallion is worn by Dr. Tom W. Bryant, President of Pittsburg State University.

Both pieces were designed and handcrafted by Samuel Farmer, a student in art at Pittsburg State University. Mr. Farmer received a Bachelor of Arts with a major in Art from the University in 1981 and a Master of Science with a major in Art Education in 1984.

In the Middle Ages, maces were used as weapons for breaking the armor of enemies on the field of battle. The use of maces as symbols for academic institutions originated in England in the 1500's.

The University's Mace features metal sculpture of sterling silver, with a staff sectioned of lathe-turned cherry wood. The school colors are present in the gold-plating in the head and knurl elements and the bezel-set red garnet cabochons. Echoing the hexagonal shape of the head, six forged flange sections radiate outward from the center, which is tipped by a half-sphere. A photo-etched seal of the University is attached to the base of the head. The knurl segment, interrupting the flow of the staff, acts as a balance, repeating the contrast between the smooth, highly-polished sterling silver and the reticulated gold-plated areas.

The Presidential Medallion is fashioned in color, scheme and line to compliment the Mace, drawing on a close-up perspective of the seal of the University.
