Tonights season's opener should prove to be a game worth attending. The Kansas State College Gorillas are squaring off against Western State College of Gunnison, Colorado. Last year the Mountaineers of Western had a season record of 6-2-1. They are picked by a coaches poll of the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference of the Mountain and Plains Intercollegiate Athletic Association to place first in the RMAC this year. Gunnison has nine offensive starters returning, including All-Conference Guard Carl Mikesell and Quarterback Mike Busly. Their four returning defensive starters are led by All-Conference End Jay Chapman.

KSC has 15 returning letter-men and was chosen in a pre-season poll of Great Plains Athletic Conference coaches to finish second in the conference behind Northern

Colorado. The Gorillas' offensive unit will have the talents of last season's quarterback sensations Chuck Smith and Dennis Harvey best aerial quarterbacks at KSC in recent years. Aiding the two are Ends Mike Powell and Allen Spencer, both proven receivers from the 1971 season. The KSC rushing department features Rick Lewis at fullback, Larry Gilliland, sophomore halfback, and the tough defensive squad will again have the speed and tackling ability of Mike McGraw, halfback, to aid a strong line, that could easily be the best in the conference. Though a young team, show great promise for this season and what they may lack in experience could be made up in good coaching and a desire to win.

State of St. Joseph, Mo. The Gorillas marched on until they met a 14-14 tie against Fort Hays State. It wasn't until two weeks later that KSC was dealt its only loss of the season by the 1971 Conference Champion University of Northern Colorado. In the next week's game against Southern Colorado prospects were anything but bright with the Gorillas trailing 24-0 at the end of the third quarter. However, the talents of the freshman quarterback, Dennis Harvey, who had replaced injured Chuck Smith one week before, were unleashed to bring the Crimson and Gold to a surprising 26-24 victory. In the last three games of the season against Omaha, Washburn, and Emporia the Gorillas showed their might with three straight wins, an 8-1-1 season record, and a runner up finish in division play.

The competition is keen, and participation is competitive in a friendly manner.
