Tonight the Kansas State College Gorillas will host the Tigers of Fort Hays State College for the 45th meeting of the two teams. The Gorilla gridders will be entertaining the traditional "Parents' Night" crowd, while vowing that last years 14-14 tie game with Fort Hays will not be repeated on Brandenburg field tonight.

The Tigers will be under the direction of Coach Bill Giles who is in his first year as head coach at Fort Hays and finds himself in a season of rebuilding. With 22 returning lettermen and 13 returning starters, Coach Giles has obtained a 0-3-1 record this season with a defeat of 45-16 at the hands of conference favorite Northern Colorado. His strong defensive unit boasts a heavy line averaging over 220 pounds and they are backed up by middle linebacker J. D. Armstrong who has proven his defensive abilities throughout the season. The Tigers offense will show the talents of tailback Steve Crosby who last week rushed 21 times for 106 of the 110 yards rushing of the Tigers. Making the Tiger aerial attack a threat will be John Woodworth, split end, who is second in receptions in the Great Plains Athletic Conference next only to our own Alan Spencer. The Tigers won't be

an easy team to beat, they will be trying to put a win on their record and tonight KSC is the target.

The Gorillas are returning home with a 3-1-0 record after a hard won victory over Kansas State Teachers College last week. At the end of the first half of play it looked like the Hornets of KSTC were going to walk off with the game having scored 21 points to the Gorillas 0 in the first half, but the Gorillas came back a different ball club. In the third period, quarterback Chuck Smith passed to Mike Powell for 45 yards from the Gorilla 31 yard line and with the help of a penalty the Gorillas found themselves on the Hornet 12 yard line. Smith handed the ball to Robin Gifford but he found himself stopped at the line. With second and ten to go Smith found Alan Spencer in the open and passed for the TD. Matthews attempt for the point after proved to be no good and at the end of the third quarter the score was KSTC 21, KSC 6.

At the beginning of the fourth quarter things still looked dark for the Gorillas, because the Hornet defense had only allowed a total of 20 points to be scored against them in their first three games. However, the Gorilla defense was showing their stuff and the offense was moving the ball right through the Hornets defensive line. With about seven minutes left in the game the Gorillas took control of the ball on the Hornet 25 and on the first play of the series the Gorillas found themselves with a penalty for 15 yards but the Gorillas were on the move and nothing could stop them. Eleven plays later the Crimson and Gold found themselves with second and goal with a yard to go when Smith on a keeper went in for the score. The Gorillas tried for two but the attempt was stopped by the Hornets and the score was 21-12 and only 5 minutes 37 seconds left in the game. Then on the first down after the kickoff the Hornets fumbled and Merle Clark recovered the ball for KSC on the Hornet 10 yard line and the Gorillas fans were out of their seats and didn't get a chance to sit down for the rest of the game. With the ball on the 10 yard line Smith on a keeper moved the ball to the two. With second and goal Smith handed to Rick Lewis for the touchdown. Matthews kicked the extra point and the Gorillas were within two points of KSTC with only four minutes and 41 seconds left to play. Then with 3 minutes 11 seconds left the Hornet center made a bad pass to the punter and the Gorillas took the ball on the Hornet 27 yard line. Time was running out but Coach Tom Lester knew his team would come through and with only 37 seconds left Smith gave the ball to Lewis and Lewis gave the Gorillas the winning touchdown. Matthews kicked the extra point and the only statistic that really counts was placed on the score board KSC 26 KSTC 21.

Tonight Fort Hays State won't be easy but the Gorillas will be ready and looking for a second conference win.
