Tonight the Kansas State College of Pittsburg Gorillas play host to their rivals from across the way, the Hornets of the Kansas State College of Emporia. Last year Pittsburg handed Emporia a 26-21 defeat, one of Emporia's 3 losses compared to their 7 victories.

Coach Harold 'Bud' Elliott will have 31 returning lettermen, 18 of those starters back from last season's conference champions. Coach Elliott is looking forward to another successful campaign, aided by the return of his complete backfield with quarterbacking duties handled by Mike White.

Pittsburg will be trying to regain status after the opening the season with back to back losses. Showing great ability early in the season is Sophomore fullback, Randy Fruits. In Pittsburg's last home contest against Northwest Missouri State, Randy carried the pigskin 16 times while averaging 5.3 yards a carry. He also had one long gainer of 38 yards which contributed to setting up Pittsburg's first TD this season. The Gorillas should show good aggressive determination in tonight's home game.
