Went to the farm yesterday. Plowed for the wheat about one half sowed. We are putting a new roof on the house - which was damaged by the hail. Still waiting to see if it is a war. I feel that a peace will have to



patched up since Poland  
is now lost. I feel that  
the Young Communist Party  
in France, may cause  
France to drop out. Russia  
might engage or join  
in a 3 way pact with  
Germany and France  
and leave England  
and the "Democracies"?  
hold the stick. However  
we shall shortly see  
what we shall see.  
Am in hurry to  
get this off. Write  
soon - Love as ever,

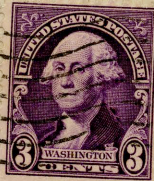
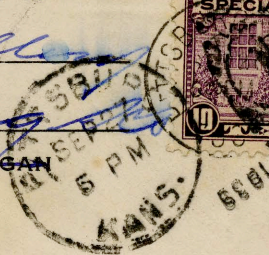
