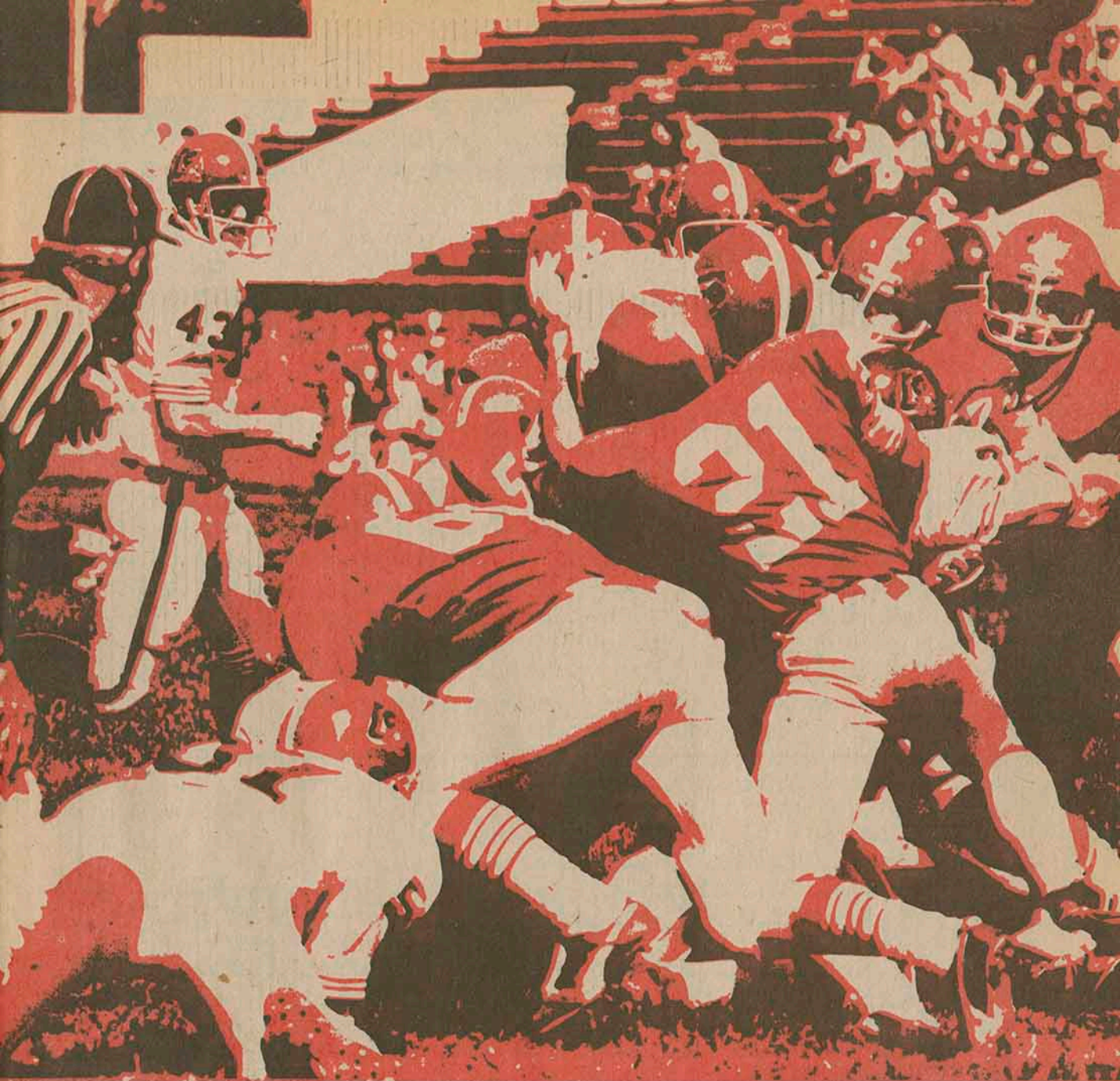

The Kansas State College of Pittsburg will try to make it two in a row today's Homecoming contest against Emporia Kansas State College.

The Gorillas lifted to victory by four big plays against Kearney, Nebraska last week, hope to catch Emporia down after their loss to Washburn, 42-13 last Saturday.

But don't count too much on that.

The Hornets have one of the nation's leading passers in quarterback Steve Hamilton. And to go along with Hamilton's passing is wide receiver Tyron Gray, who also is listed high in NAIA statistics. This combination can turn any game around in just one play.

The Gorillas, according to Head Coach Tom Lester, have been working on a pass rush this week in preparation for Hamilton & Co., and also on moving the ball on offense. "We need to improve our offense and execution in BOTH HALVES if we expect to win," he stated. Lester also pointed out that the Gorillas "haven't lost a homecoming game in eight years, and we don't plan to lose this one."

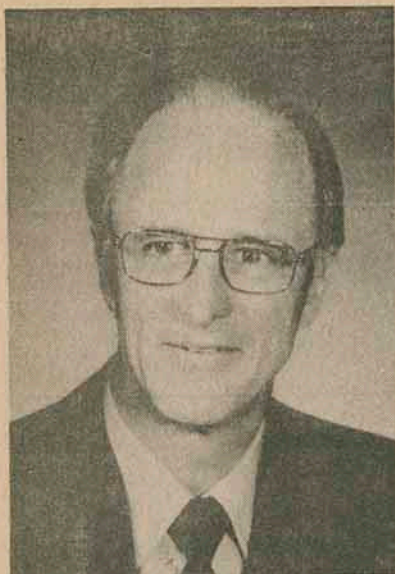
