Biographical Sketch

One of the oldest continuously running coal companies in the United States was the Pittsburg & Midway Coal Company founded in Pittsburg, Kansas in 1885. It lasted under that name even after its move to Denver, Colorado when the Kansas mines closed, until September 2007, when Chevron which owned the company, merged it with its Molycorp Inc. coal mining division to form Chevron Mining, thus ending the Pittsburg corporate name. The name Pittsburg & Midway Coal Company was purchased from Chevron in 2008 and refounded in Midway, Kansas. Today P&M owns mines in Oklahoma, Texas, Kentucky and Ohio.

Pittsburg & Midway operated in Southeast Kansas from its inception up until large scale coal mining ceased in the area in the late 20th century. The indelible mark of coal mining is visible on the Southeast Kansas landscape and in such sights as Big Brutus, a 16 story-tall power shovel operated by Pittsburg and Midway Coal Company that now stands near West Mineral, Kansas as a memorial and museum.
