

Pittsburg State University welcomes you to its 1977 home opener with the Miners from the University of Missouri at Rolla. Pitt State, led by Ron Randleman in his second year at the helm, brings a 0-2 record into the contest, while the Miners have been victorious once in three games.

An aerial show may be in store tonight as both teams enjoy throwing the ball. Pitt State's Mark Hittner has completed 23 passes for 289 yards in his first two ballgames. Slotback Greg Smith and Tight End Pete Peltzer are two of Hittner's favorite receivers. The pair has a combined total of 15 catches in only two games.

UMR attempted 47 passes last week in its loss to Missouri Southern of Joplin. The Miners led by Senior quarterback Kenny Vaughn, amassed 289 yards through the air. Vaughn's favorite target is Andrew Cox a 6'3' 205 lb. wide receiver.

An added note to Gorialla followers is the four-game junior varsity schedule which Pitt State resumed this season. The first home junior varsity contest is scheduled for Monday October 17 against Missouri Southern beginning at 7:30 p.m.
