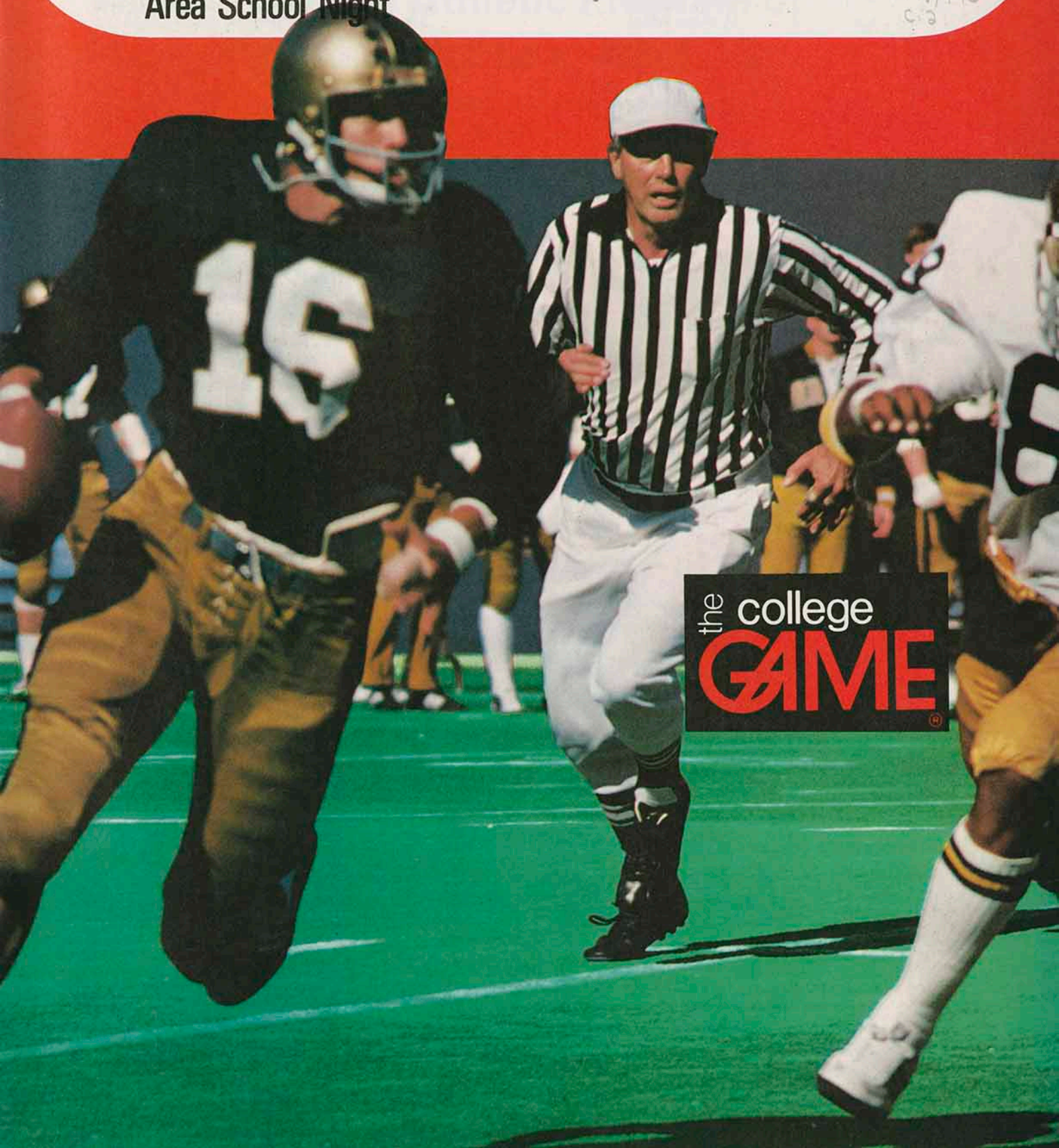

Tonight's Area School Night game here at Brandenburg Stadium will feature the young and explosive Pitt State Gorillas, as they take on the Bears of Southwest Missouri State, with hopes of repeating their fine performance last week in a 30-10 victory over Northwest Missouri State.

The Gorillas played impressive football last week, maintaining poise on defense, and stopping several Bearcat drives, frustrating the NMS offense, and attacking hard on offense with a strong running game that features the quickness of Boney Green, and the powerful rushing and fine moves of Richard Overton coming out of the backfield.

The Bears look to be a fine test of the Gorillas, boasting nine returning starters on offense, and 12 returning letterman on defense.

The Bears are a tough team to run against, strong up the middle. They have three three-year lettermen in the defensive secondary and should prove difficult to pass against also.

Expecting to lead the Gorillas to their second consecutive victory is Mark Hittner, Pitt State quarterback. Mark was impressive last week, picking up 55 yards rushing, and directing the club to four scoring drives, as Pitt State picked up 402 yards total offense.

SMS will undoubtedly be keyed on Green after his 159 yard rushing performance last week, and Overton, who picked up 131 yards and all four Gorilla touchdowns, while the young Pitt State defense will have it's hands full as they try and stop the veteran Bear offense.

The CSIC was formed in the school year 1976-77 after the break-up of the Great Plains Athletic Conference. Ft. Hays, Pittsburg, Emporia, Washburn, and Kearney were members of the GPAC. Wayne State, Missouri Western, and Missouri Southern were added to form the new conference. All members have a national affiliation with the NAIA.

In the two years of its existence the CSIC has proven to be one of the strongest athletic conferences within the NAIA structure. During the 1977-78 school year seven athletic teams from CSIC schools finished among the top ten in NAIA national competition. The 1978-79 school year promises to be another outstanding year for conference schools at the national level.

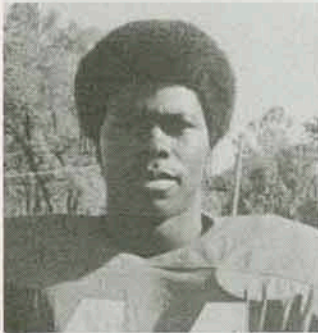

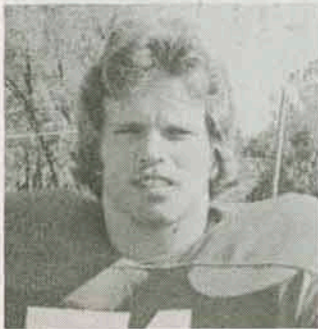
## Gorilla Spotlight

Sophomore running sensation Richard Overton returns to lead the Pitt State Gorillas and is off to a fine start with his 131 yard, four touchdown performance last week against the Bearcats.

Rushing for 850 yards last season in six games as a regular, Richard led the Gorillas offense, and was named the Pitt State Most Valuable Player. He is a fine man both on and off the field, Coach Ron Randleman feels. The Coach has set high goals for the young man from Booneville, Mo., and thinks with an injury-free season, Richard is capable of rushing for 1000 yards. Richard is a hard worker and a tremendous football player.

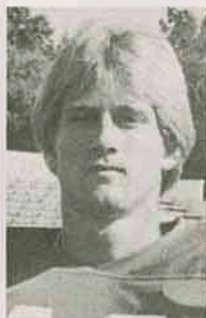

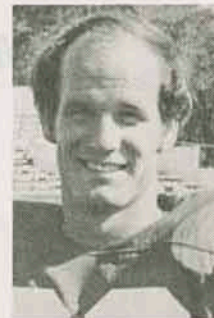

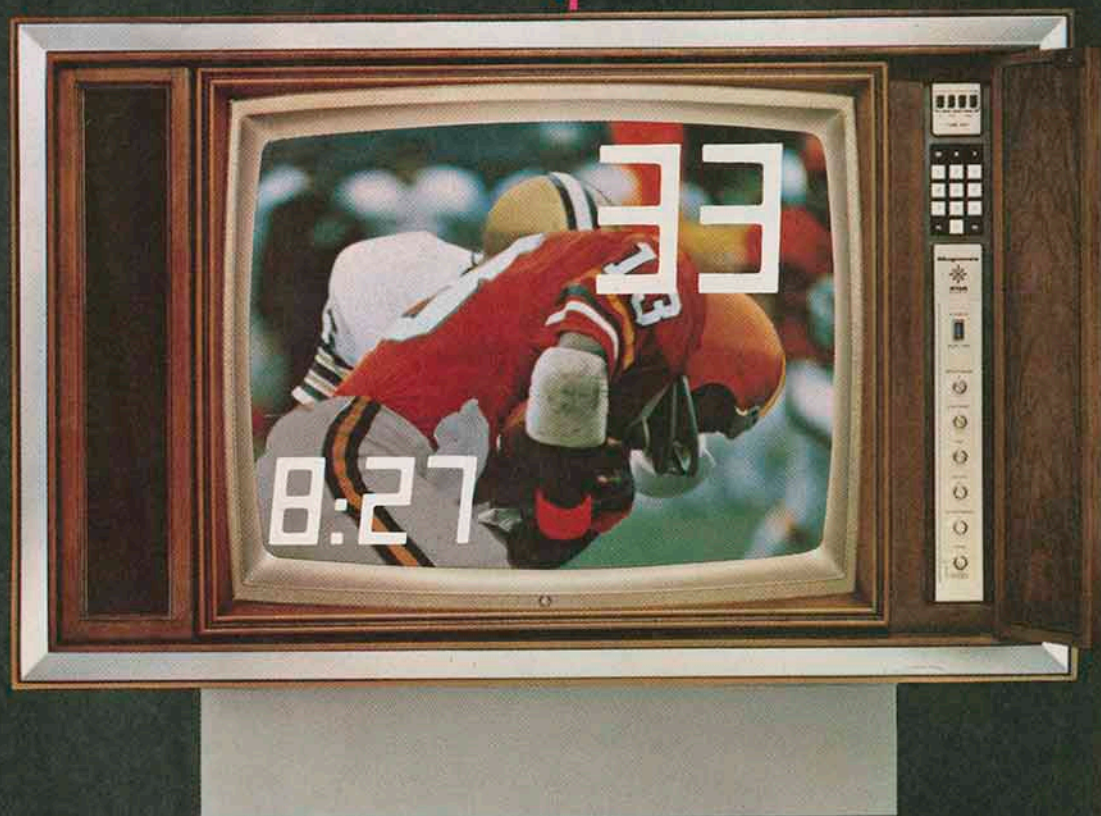
