

The young Gorillas have played championship football the past three weeks, combining a strong offense, passing the ball well and a hard rushing attack, with superb defense that shut-out a nationally ranked Kearney State team, and whipped Missouri Western.

The attackers, led by Mark Hittner, Boonville, Mo., junior, at the quarterback position, have proved to be a high scoring unit, with a balanced running game, and highlighted by an exciting passing attack.

The Wildcats come into Brandenburg Stadium hoping to repeat the results of last year's meeting between the two teams, as Pitt State dropped a 30-7 battle in Wayne's homecoming

Pitt State's overall record now stands at 3-3, with a 2-1 mark for play in the Central States Intercollegiate Conference. The game today should be a battle as the Gorillas hope to avenge last years' defeat and turn things around after their loss last week to the Tigers of Fort Hays.

The Gorillas were quilty of several costly penalties, and made too many turnovers as Fort Hays ended up with a hard fought 35-30 victory.

The game marks the official beginning of the 75th Anniversary of the University, and the Gorillas hope it will mark the beginning of a Pitt State conference victory drive.




## 1978 Athletic Scholarship Drive




