



Tonight's Pitt State Gorilla home opener with the University of Missouri-Rolla Miners also marks PSU's annual observance of Area School Night honoring numerous guests from area high schools in the University's major service area. The Gorillas are 1-1 so far for the season and the Miners are 1-1, but the Missourians had last weekend off while Pitt State battled a determined Southwest Missouri State in a tough 41-37 loss at Springfield.

Rolla was 8-3 last year while winning third place in the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association conference. Eight starters return from the good defensive team of 1978, including all-MIAA performer Kevin Wolf, a senior linebacker.

The Missouri offense was hard hit by graduation and Head Coach Charles Finley is reestablishing a relatively new crew in that department for this year's challenging season. Last year the Rolla Miners beat Pitt State 38-21 at Rolla.






## **Gorilla Spotlight**



RICHARD OVERTON

One of the bright spots for the Gorillas this season, has been the clutch running of running back, Richard Overton, who was selected as this week's offensive player of the week by the PSU coaching staff. In two games for PSU this season, Overton has averaged 92.5 per game and has scored three touchdowns. Last week against SMS, Overton rushed for 91 yards on 26 carries and two touchdowns.

Going into this season, he had gained 1500 yards on the ground over a two year span for the Gorillas. Richard's best year was his freshmen year, when he was voted the team's most valuable player. In that year, he gained 850 yards on just 179 attempts. Last season, he rushed for 648 yards, but more importantly, scored 11 touchdowns.

Another bright spot for the Gorillas this season has been the key defensive play of Brett Holtom. Holtom, named this week's defensive player of the week, a 6'0", 195 pound defensive back from Topeka, Ks., is only a sophomore, but started the last seven games of the season a year ago. He is a Business Administration major at PSU.

Holtom had a very big game against SMS also. In that game, he was in on 13 tackles, three of which were unassisted, he recovered one fumble, broke up one pass, and intercepted another which set up a PSU touchdown. This was Brett's second fine defensive performance of the season, as he was in on 11 tackles in the NMS game, with five of those being unassisted.


