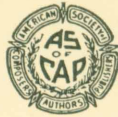

3. Brief sketch of career with particular reference to activities in music.
4. List of more important works -- also any noteworthy fact concerning any particular work.
5. Present home address. If you wish specific address withheld, please give simply the city or town with notation "Address care of ASCAP, 30 Rockefeller Plaza, New York 20, N. Y. --- or
6. If deceased, date and place of death.

To simplify this procedure, we have prepared a sketch of you from such information as we have available here. This is enclosed. Won't you please read this carefully, check for errors, and supply all additional information needed to round out an accurate and complete entry for the ASCAP directory?
