The Wonder Boys have been ranked as one of the nations top teams in the pre-season NAIA poll. The Wonder Boys finished the 1983 season with 4-5-1 record, but lost only six players to graduation. Last years 6-4 Gorillas team lost 13 seniors.

This evenings game is the season opener for both teams. The two teams have met only once previously with Pitt State hanging on for an exciting 17-14 victory. The Wonder Boys offense is led by Quarterback Harold Moore, and Tailback Stacy Johnson. Pitt States offense is under the direction of Steve Siebuhr who is accompanied in the backfield by tailback Willie Brown. On defense players to watch are Marty Davis and David Luster from Arkansas Tech, and Paris Long and Rob Kaelin from PSU.

The CSIC was formed in 1976-77 after the break-up of the Great Plains Athletic Conference. Ft. Hays, Pittsburg, Emporia, Washburn, and Kearney were members of the GPAC. Wayne State, Missouri Western, and Missouri Southern were added to form the new conference. All members have a national affiliation with the NAIA.

In the eight years of its existence the CSIC has proven to be one of the strongest athletic conferences within the NAIA structure. During the 1983-84 school year several athletic teams from CSIC schools ranked among the top twenty in NAIA competition. This included a first place national finish by the Fort Hays State men's basketball squad and a fourteenth place finish by Pittsburg State in men's outdoor track. The 1984 school year promises to be another outstanding year for conference schools at the national level.



Three names Pitt State football fans will be hearing often this season are Steve Siebuhr, Larry Audley, and David Hammons. These senior Gorillas have had outstanding seasons in the past, and they are expected to repeat those preformances this year.

Steve Siebuhr, 5'11", 175 lbs., quarterback from Columbus, KS, holds several PSU passing records including most completions in a game, most passes completed in a season, and most yardage passing per game for a season. He was honorable mention on the all CSIC team, completing 101 of 199 for 1411 yards and 10 touchdowns. He also rushed for 194 yards and another 6 TD's.

Larry Audley, 6'1", 200 lbs., linebacker from Iola, KS, ranks second among active players in total tackles after just one season with the Gorillas. He was credited with 89 tackles of which 53 were unassisted. He had 6 pass deflections, 2 quarterback sacks and a fumble recovery for last years squad.

David Hammons, 6'0'', 220 lbs., punter and place kicker from Osawatomie, KS, leads all active players in scoring with 122 points. Last season he set a personal best by kicking a 49 yard field goal. For his punting accomplishments he was picked honorable mention all CSIC in 1983. He punted 55 times for 2108 yards and a 38.c yard average.
