

The Pittsburg State University Gorillas are making their second home appearance of the 1984 campaign against the Tigers of Fort Hays State University. Both teams are 1-1 in conference play. Fort Hays, 4-1 on the season, was ranked eighth in the nation before losing to Kearney State in the Tigers' conference opener two weeks ago. Last weekend they bounced back to defeat Wayne State 21-14. The 2-2 Gorillas also lost their conference opener but were able to score a 21-20 victory against Washburn last weekend.

This will be the 57th meeting of the two schools since the series originated back in 1926. Pittsburg State has the advantage with a 31-17-8 record against the Tigers. In last year's game, the Gorillas defeated the a previously unbeaten Fort Hays team 29-25.

Athletic Scholarship Drive



Central States Intercollegiate Conference

The CSIC was formed in 1976-77 after the break-up of the Great Plains Athletic Conference. Ft. Hays, Pittsburg, Emporia, Washburn, and Kearney were members of the GPAC. Wayne State, Missouri Western, and Missouri Southern were added to form the new conference. All members have a national affiliation with the NAIA.

In the eight years of its existence the CSIC has proven to be one of the strongest athletic conferences within the NAIA structure. During the 1983-84 school year several athletic teams from CSIC schools ranked among the top twenty in NAIA competition. This included a first place national finish by the Fort Hays State men's basketball squad and a fourteenth place finish by Pittsburg State in men's outdoor track. The 1984 school year promises to be another outstanding year for conference schools at the national level.



For their outstanding performances in Pittsburg State's 21-20 victory over Washburn University, the Gorilla Coaching Staff has named Willie Brown, Kent Thompson, and Dave Hammons as PSU's "Players of the Week."

Brown, 6-1, 205 lbs., senior tailback from Beggs, Oklahoma, was chosen offensive player of the week. Last week he rushed for 136 yards on 18 carries, including touchdown runs of 9 and 63 yards. For the season Willie has 339 yards on 59 carries and has scored four touchdowns.

Thompson, 6'0", 205 lbs., junior linebacker from Iola, Kansas, was chosen as the Gorilla defensive player of the week with ten unassisted and three assisted tackles on the muddy turf in Topeka. He had a quarterback sack and made the game-saving tackle as Washburn attempted but failed to score on a 2-point conversion after drawing to 21-20 late in the game.

Hammons, 6'-0", 220 lbs., senior kicker, was named the specialty teams player of the week. Dave was three for three in PAT's and punted three times for a 51-yard average at Washburn. For the year Dave is ten of ten in PAT's and two of four for field goals for a total of 16 points. He has also punted 17 times for a 35.8 yard average.
