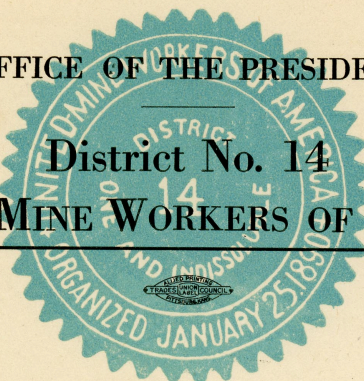

Some few days ago the District Executive Board sent a circular letter to all Local Unions advising that upon the 26th, action would be taken by the District Board, submitting the Four Per Cent question to the membership for a vote.
