Dear Carson:

The distance from Pleasant Valley to Falls Village is even less than I thought. Coming back to Amherst Sunday night, I inquired at a filling station as to the location of the Regional High School and secured the following directions for you: Follow Route 144 to the point where it intersects Route 126. This is before you get to Canaan. Follow Route 126 (right) to Falls Village. Just before you get to the center, you will come to a railroad underpass. Go through the underpass and turn left. The Regional High School is one-half mile down this road on the right-hand side.

I am enclosing all the dances with notes that will enable you to work out the musical routines. Write or give me a ring (person to person) if you have any question.

For possible recording dates, I will tentatively hold Monday, April 21, and Monday, April 28. If either of these dates is o.k., I could plan to get down on Sunday in order to have the entire day for rehearsing and recording. What would be the possibilities of your bringing one or two couples down with you? If you could do that, I think I could perhaps line up enough others so that we could have a set in the studio. Then after we made a recording, on the play-back we could have the set go through the dance to make sure that it was o.k. Please let me know on the dates as soon as possible.

I certainly enjoyed the visit with you and your family Sunday. I had two flat tires on the return trip and didn't arrive home until 3:30 A.M.
