Biographical Note

Morris Cliggitt was born in Oswego, Kendall County, Illinois, in 1854, to Irish immigrants Morris and Julia Russel Cliggitt. He grew up on the family's farm, attended local schools, and later the academy in Oswego, Illinois.

He attended Northwestern College at Naperville, Illinois for three years and taught school afterwards in that area for several years. He later studied law, along with classmate William Jennings Bryan, at the Union College of Law at Chicago, graduating in 1883 with high honors.

Following graduation he began practicing law with his brother, John, in Mason City, Iowa from June 1883 to March 1884. He then moved to Hastings, Nebraska, to open a law office. While living in Hastings he was also the assistant cashier of the Exchange National Bank until January 1887. He continued to work in the banking business in Culbertson, Nebraska, but eventually returned to his legal practice. While in Nebraska, he became involved in politics and joined the Democratic Party. Throughout the rest of his life he served the Democratic Party on local, state, and national levels.

Cliggitt moved to Pittsburg, Kansas in January 1890, and partnered with Ed Van Gundy in the law firm of Van Gundy and Cliggitt until Van Gundy's death in September 1894. He served several years as the attorney for the National Bank of Pittsburg and the area smelter industries and coal companies.

Cliggitt married Celia Grier in McCook, Nebraska, in 1891. They had one daughter that died during infancy.

Morris Cliggitt continued to delve in local and broader politics after moving to Pittsburg. He was appointed City Attorney several times and was appointed Assistant U.S. District Attorney for Kansas during President Grover Cleveland's administration from December 1893 to July 1894. In 1896 Cliggitt served as one of the national Democratic electors from Kansas. He also served as Chairman of the Democratic Central Committee at various times during a ten-year period. He was one of the major stockholders in the Pittsburg, Frontenac, and Suburban Electric Railway Company and served as its president in 1898.

Cliggitt served on the Board of Directors and as President for the Free City Library since its inception in 1902 until he was elected mayor of Pittsburg in April 1909. As mayor, he helped establish the Pittsburg Public Library when he and the city council approached philanthropist Andrew Carnegie to help build a public library on the corners of Walnut and 4th streets. Carnegie provided funding and the Pittsburg Public Library was built in 1910. The library received the majority of Cliggitt's private library following his death and maintained it as a separate collection for many years.

Morris Cliggitt died December 23, 1909, at the age of 55, due to complications from gall stones surgery. He is buried in St. Mary's Cemetery in Pittsburg, Kansas.

The City of Pittsburg, Kansas, Correspondence and Ordinances series consists of fourteen subseries: Coal; Railways; City Schools; Library; City Property; City Police; City Prohibition; City Blocks; City Sidewalks; City Streets; City Water Works; City Sewer Districts; City Energy; and City Miscellaneous. Of particular historical interest in the various subseries within this series are the committees, correspondence, and legal documents that Morris Cliggitt was involved with during his tenure as city attorney and mayor throughout the early years of Pittsburg, Kansas, including the creation of the City Library, now known as the Pittsburg Public Library, and expansion of city utilities and property. The Railway subseries includes documents relating to Pittsburg Electric Railway Company; Fort Scott and Memphis Railroad Company; Kansas City, Pittsburg and Western Railroad Company; Pittsburg, Fort Smith and Southern Railroad Company; Pittsburg, Frontenac and Suburban Electric Railway Company; Pittsburg Railroad Company; Mineral Cities Railway Company; St. Louis and San Francisco Railroad Company; Joplin & Pittsburg Railway Company; Kansas City Southern Railway Company; Pittsburg & Kansas City Railway Company; Pittsburg Railway & Light Company; and Kansas City, Pittsburg & Gulf Railroad.

The **Democratic Party** series contains documents and correspondence pertaining to Cliggitt's work with the Democratic Party from 1885-1909.

The **Historical Manuscripts** series contains two photocopied research papers; one written by Sharon Harrison for a history class in 1980 entitled, "Morris Cliggitt and the Pittsburg Free Library" telling the history of how Cliggitt was one of the founders of the city library, now Pittsburg Public Library. The other research paper, co-authored by Pittsburg State University history faculty members, Robert K. Ratzlaff and Thomas R. Walther, is entitled "Morris Cliggitt and George Nicholson: Two Architects of Industrialization in Southeastern Kansas." This research paper gives details into the two decades that Cliggitt served his clients who were involved in the zinc smelting, coal, railroad, trolley lines, and banking industries in Southeast Kansas.

The **Manuscripts** series consists of works hand and typewritten by Cliggitt from the 1880s through 1904.

The **Certificates** series contain various certificates including Cliggitt's teaching certificates, Bachelor of Law degree from Chicago University and Northwestern University, Illinois, practicing attorney certificates, and election certificates from October 1873 through April 1909.

The **City of Pittsburg, Kansas License** Series includes the licenses Cliggitt purchased in order to practice law from 1891 through 1909 in Pittsburg, Kansas.

The **Cards** series includes a college grade card; various railway passes; wallet calendars; banquet/ball tickets; political cards; and various business cards dating from 1878 to 1909.

The **Personal Publications** series is comprised of several printed publications written by Morris Cliggitt.

The **Financial Records** series contains receipts and invoices dating from 1879 through 1909 and undated receipts.

The **Photographs** series consists of three undated photographs of Morris Cliggitt; several undated photographs of his birthplace home in Oswego, Illinois as well as photo reproduction postcards of various places in Oswego, Illinois, Germany, and Finland.

The **News Clippings** series includes various political writings that Cliggitt collected and articles regarding various cases and activities he was involved in throughout his professional career. Of particular interest is an article talking about the Pittsburg City Library's first year anniversary as well as political articles Cliggitt wrote regarding Socialism.

The **Legal** series is arranged into nine subseries: Judicial Law and Political Notes; Affidavits and Statements; Contracts and Agreements; Bankruptcy; Mortgages; Estate Wills, Estate Miscellaneous Petitions; Court Case Briefs; and Kansas Bar Association Annual Meetings.

The **State of Kansas Publications** series includes printed publications of various State of Kansas court cases held in the Supreme Court of Kansas and the Supreme Court of the United States.

The **State of Kansas Legislature** series includes an undated blank warrant; copy of an undated typewritten document entitled "Quarantine Regulations of the State Board of Health"; *Index to Code of Civil Procedure*. 1909; and *Supplement to the Kansas Legislature*. 1893.

The **Other States Publications** series contains printed publications from Iowa, Territory of Montana, Nebraska, New York, and Texas, dating from 1885 to 1904.

The **Miscellaneous States Publications** series includes *Slavery in Kansas*. 1902; *Bimetallism Monometallism with the Most Rev. Dr. Walsh*. 1893; and *Speech of John Cliggett, National Democratic Candidate for Governor of Iowa*. 1897."

The **Federal Publications** series contains printed reports dating from 1800 through 1904 as well as a few undated publications.
