You look just as spry as you did ^{at} ~~in~~ 1819 Broadway back in the old days of the Columbia recording sessions with Vernon Dalhart, Frank Luther, Frank Walker and myself. Possibly you remember those sessions.

Relative to your M-G-M record 10110 "Shady Valley Waltz", I wish you would make more of this type recording for my particular territory as it has been received much better than the other singles released to date. They particularly like the way you do your whistling and the sentiment attached to the lyrics.

Your M-G-M Album 5 is doing very well. About the only criticism I get is that they like square dance music more or less without calls. However, the album is doing very well for us.

If you are ever down this way, be sure and pay us a visit.
