RAY CAULDER . . . . . David Welch

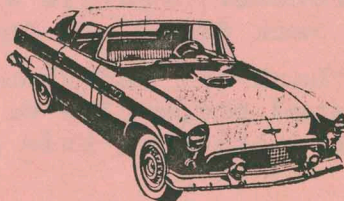
Younger brother and larger than Roy. Slope-
