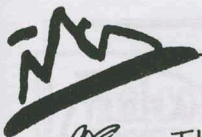

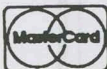
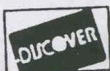

F

rom the Director . . .

I saw the original New York Theatreworks/USA workshop production **WHEN THE COOKIE CRUMBLES You Can Still Pick Up the Pieces** in the summer of 1984, and I was struck by the fact that it was being billed as a "children's show" for this very prominent National Touring Company. My first thought was that it should be viewed by every adult that ever considered having children! I found it entertaining, educational, inspiring, and touching . . . all of the elements I like to experience when I go to the theatre, on any level.

Also, interestingly, after all these years since it's creation, we see the early talents of the composer/lyricist team, Stephen Flaherty and Lynne Ahrens, who recently won the 1998 Tony Award for their lyrics and musical score of **RAGTIME**, and prior to that, **MY FAVORITE YEAR**, and **ONCE ON THE ISLAND**. The writing team of Marta Kaufman and David Crane, who are now well known for their successful TV series, "Friends," has also contributed to this little musical revue. It is truly a collaborative effort to create a new format of presentational theatre, including 17 additional composers, lyricists, and playwrights.

I believe that kids and young adults are smart. They are overstimulated with new technology, adult information, and personal experiences, and I have never believed, even in my public school teaching days, that kids should be talked down to, or just told "nice" stories. Kids are people too, and, as we see in some of the scenes in this play, they are faced with the personal responsibility of sorting out problems and making decisions that will affect them for the rest of their lives.
