| Biographical Note | Marie Bezinque emigrated from France to Oklahoma in 1892 when it was still Indian Territory. She arrived with her infant son and three brothers. They were to meet their father and Marie's husband Jules Merciez. Jules and Marie would have 10 children born in Oklahoma and Kansas; Jules (1890-1968), Alice (1892-1988), Matilda (1894), Alec (1896-1971), Irene (1899-1947), Clemence (1903-1995), Raymond (1907-1965), Edith (1909-2004), Walter (1910-1938) and Amelia (1913-2012). Clemence Merciez married Henry DeGruson on September 25, 1926. They had four sons, Henry, Eugene 'Gene', James and Walter. Gene DeGruson began to put together the genealogy of his family with help from cousins and other family members. The Merciez family and all of its branches had a family reunion in 1989. |
