Biographical Note	Dorothy Jenkins was born September 19, 1916, in Pittsburg, Kansas. Her parents were Tiffin and Rosa Jenkins. She attended Pittsburg public schools and was a graduate of Pittsburg State University. She earned a master's degree in journalism from the University of Kansas. She was married to Glenn Elliott. Mrs. Elliott taught in number of Kansas elementary and high schools. She served as superintendent of schools in Dickinson County, Kansas, and director of the Journalism Education Association. She was an instructor of journalism at Haskell Indian Nations University until her retirement. She was a member of the Kansas Women's Press Association, Welda First United Methodist Church, and the American

Association of University Women. Dorothy Jenkins Elliott passed away on February 28, 2007.

Scope and Content Note

Series Descriptions

The **Art** series contains artwork of Native Americans.

The **Brochures** series contains various announcements, information on Art Galleries, and a Pow-Wow.

The **Constitution and By-Laws** series contains the Constitution and By-Laws of the American Indian Press Association.

The **Correspondence** series contains correspondence to and from Dorothy Jenkins Elliott, and events being held at the Nelson Gallery-Atkins Museum.

The **Guide to AIPA Release Information** series contains a guide to the different codes used in the news releases.

The **Newsletters** series contains various newsletters from different Native American organizations with articles about books, poetry, music, and information on help centers.

The **News Release** series contains numerous news articles on individuals and Indian affairs.

The **Newspaper Clippings** series contains clippings on Native American culture and news and information.

The **Notes** series contains notes.

The **Periodicals** series contains magazines of Native American art, culture, and photographs.

The **Photographs** series includes photos of Native American artifacts.

The **Survey** series contains a survey of plans to build classrooms for a school.

The **Reports, Government** series contains reports on various Native American related information.

The **Books** series contains books on Native American culture and stories which was used in the classroom.
