I also checked with the Buffalo Airport and the last flight that leaves Buffalo is at 8:15 p.m. and arrives in New York at 10:37 p.m. Reservations have not been made for this flight.

We are planning to have a record booth at the Armory, alongside Radio Station WEBR. We will display and sell all of Carson's recordings. The proceeds will be turned over to the Buffalo Courier Express Toy Fund.
