<b>Biographical Note</b>	John Harry was born on September 2, 1918 and died June 27, 2007. He graduated from Kansas State Teachers College (Pittsburg State University) in 1949, and in 1960 with a Master of Science Degree. He served in the US Army during World War II. Harry married Rosalyn Schultze and had one child, Micky G. Harry. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, the Elk's Club, the American Legion, and the V.F.W. of Pittsburg, Kansas.
