Biographical Note	Orrie Beam Kellogg (1903-1997) was born in Iowa and attended high school in Cherryvale, Kansas. She was an alumnae of Kansas State Teachers College (now Pittsburg State University), having graduated with a BA in English in 1929 and a MA in 1936. Orrie was a member of Sigma Tau Delta (English honor society) and Kappa Delta Pi (education honor society). She wrote poetry and taught journalism and English at Neodesha High School in Kansas. Orrie B. Kellogg died on November 26, 1997 in Neodesha.
