Biographical Note Audrey Beatrice Edge Andrade was born in Stockton, Missouri on January 15, 1917 to George W. and Maud Ritter Edge. Audrey grew up in Pittsburg, Kansas, attended Lakeside Elementary School, and graduated from Pittsburg High School in 1934. She received her two-year education degree from the Kansas State Teachers College (now Pittsburg State University) in 1936. She married John F. Andrade who served as a staff sergeant in the US Army during World War II. They had five children. John Andrade was a co-owner of Milhender Distributing Company, a leading New England distributor of house wares. Mrs. Andrade had an interest in music including piano, violin, and singing. John Andrade passed away in 1978 and Audrey Andrade passed away in 1996. The couple are buried in Rhode Island Veterans Memorial Cemetery, in Exeter, Rhode Island.
