Donald Sinta is Associate Professor of Saxophone at the University of Michigan and previously taught at Ithaca College in New York and at the Hartt College of Music in Connecticut. He is a graduate of Wayne State University and the University of Michigan. He has performed frequently at music education conferences, band workshops, and with high school and college ensembles throughout the country.

For two years he served as saxophonist with the Detroit Symphony. Mr. Sinta was the first elected chairman of the World Saxophone Congress, an international organization for professional saxophonists. He presently serves as Region V coordinator for the North American Saxophone Alliance.

Mr. Sinta has demonstrated a great personal interest in improving the saxophonists' literature and has already had more than fifty works written for him, including compositions by Pulitzer Prize winning composers Leslie Bassett and Karel Husa.
