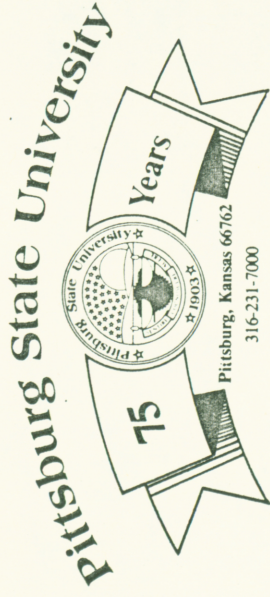

Dear Dr. Jessye:
