Several hundred Little Blue Books, published in Girard, Kansas by Emanuel Haldeman- Julius, were also donated and added to the library's Little Blue Book Collection.

Biographical Information Frank E. Laine (1909 – 1999) and Della Buset (1910 – 1992) grew up in the mining communities in Crawford County, Kansas, attending schools in Arma, Kansas. In 1938 they married. Della worked as a teacher in Crawford County schools, after attending what is now Pittsburg State University.
