Craig Fuchs is in his first year as Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Music at Pittsburg State University. His teaching responsibilities include directing the "Pride of the Plains" Marching Band, conducting both the Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band, and teaching conducting. He also serves as the faculty advisor for the CMENC chapter. Mr. Fuchs holds degrees in music education from Missouri Western State College and the University of Missouri-Columbia and is currently completing the final requirements towards a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Wind Conducting at the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music. Mr. Fuchs has ten years of teaching experience in the public schools of Kansas and Missouri, most recently as Director of Bands at Shawnee Mission West High School in Overland Park, Kansas. While at Shawnee Mission West, both his marching band and wind ensemble earned numerous honors and awards at area and regional competitions and festivals. The marching band traveled to Europe twice during his tenure and the wind ensemble appeared twice on the Kansas Music Educators Association Workshop program. Mr. Fuchs is active as a clinician and adjudicator in both marching and concert arenas throughout the midwest. He is also an active performer on trumpet in the Kansas City area. Mr. Fuchs holds memberships in MENC, KMEA, KBA, CBDNA and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.
