Biographical Note	Prentice E. Gudgen Jr. was born on April 15, 1939 to Prentice Everett and Gretta H. Stuessi Gudgen. His father was a coach at Pittsburg State University. He graduated from Pittsburg High School in 1958 and worked for McNally's Manufacturing for twenty-seven years. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Boy Scouts of America, and the Crawford County Historical Society. Gudgen was also a local historian. He passed away on June 16, 2006.

Scope and Content Note

This collection primarily focuses on the history of Crawford County, Kansas. There are 12 series in this collection: **Correspondence, Kansas History, Programs and Flyers, Publications, City Directories, Photographs, Postcards, Maps, Stationery, Clippings, Miscellaneous, and Oversized.**

1. The **Correspondence** series contains one letter. This letter was written by N. McConnell and sent to a Jones McConnell in Amity, New York (Orange County).

2. The **Kansas History** series consist of information several towns and mining communities in Southeast Kansas, and information on an early settler.
3. The **Programs and Broad Sheets** series includes programs and broad sheets for several events in Pittsburg, such as an essay competition, church services, commencements, anniversaries, and athletic events. Most of the programs are related to Pittsburg State University or the First Methodist Episcopal Church.
4. The **Publications** series contains various forms of publication on a variety of subjects. There are five main categories in the series (Personal Book, Kansas State Teachers College, Pittsburg, Kansas, Kansas History, and Railroads). In total, there are: pictorial histories, bulletins, newsletters, reports by governmental organizations, and topic books. There is a variety of information over the development of Southeast Kansas and the University to be found.
5. The **Telephone Directories** series consist of complete and partial telephone directories of Pittsburg.
6. The **Photographs** series includes several towns in Southeast Kansas, including Pittsburg, Walnut, Hepler, Cockerill, and Girard. The pictures span over a hundred years.
7. The **Postcards** series includes scenes of Southeast Kansas towns as well as souvenir booklets. Many of the postcards are located in the albums in the Oversized collection.
8. The **Maps** series consist of a map of Pittsburg, Belgium, and Germany.
9. The **Stationery** series contains envelopes with different stamps and letterheads from the Kelso Seed Company.
10. The **Clippings** series includes newspaper clippings of Pittsburg from the early 1900s, primarily about the local mining.
11. The **Miscellaneous** series includes a 1982 calendar.
12. The **Oversized** series consist of postcard albums, envelope albums, card catalogues, slides, maps, advertisements, and newspapers.
