Carl A. Kling joined Northwest Missouri State University as Director of Bands in 2004. In that capacity, he conducts the Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band, and the "Musical Pride of Northwest" Bearcat Marching Band. He serves as the faculty advisor and administrator of the Northwest Pep Band and is the Co-Conductor of the Northwest Orchestra. In addition to these performance ensembles, Mr. Kling teaches Elements of Conducting, Instrumental Conducting, Instrumental Composition and Arranging, and Marching Band Techniques. He is the sponsor of the Kappa Delta chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi and a member of the Upsilon Chi chapter of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

Mr. Kling holds a Bachelor of Music Education Degree from Texas Wesleyan University (1991) and a Master of Arts - Wind Conducting from Stephen F. Austin State University (1993). Most recently he has completed course work and is currently in the final year of the Doctor of Music - Wind Conducting program at Indiana University. Prior to his appointment to Northwest Missouri State, Mr. Kling served as a public school band director from 1994-2001 in the North Central Region of Texas. Additionally, he has served on the faculties of Depauw University (Ind.), Texas Wesleyan University, and Hill College (Tex.) as a guest conductor and guest lecturer. Most recently, Mr. Kling has been named to Who's Who in America 2006 and was presented with the Kappa Kappa Psi Silver Baton Award for dedication to band.

As an active clinician, he has worked with top concert and marching ensembles in Indiana, Kentucky and Texas. Mr. Kling will serve as the guest conductor for the Northeast Missouri District Honor Band in January, the University of Massachusetts, Amherst Honor Band in February. Mr. Kling holds professional memberships in College Band Directors National Association, National Band Association, Kansas Music Educators Association, Iowa Music Educators Association, Nebraska Music Educators Association, Missouri Music Educators Association, and Music Educators National Conference. He is a research associate for the series *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band, Volumes 5 and 6*.

Dr. Ed Huckleby is currently a Professor of Music and Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs at Northeastern State University-Broken Arrow where he serves as the chief academic administrator for the campus. Prior to this appointment, he was an arts administrator for Tulsa Ballet Theatre, Inc, directing the general operations of Oklahoma's premier international ballet company. He also holds the title of emeritus professor of music at Northwestern Oklahoma State University where he served for over two decades as Music Department Chairman and Dean of the Graduate School.

Prior to his appointment at Northwestern in 1976, Huckleby spent eight years teaching instrumental music in the public schools of Oklahoma where his marching, concert and jazz bands won state and regional acclaim. His success in the public schools led him into the college teaching ranks where he became internationally recognized as an outstanding music educator and composer of over 160 published works for concert and marching band. Ed's ability to write interesting and accessible instrumental music can be attributed to his experience at a variety of musical levels.

Huckleby's performance background and experience is very eclectic, having been a member of a symphony orchestra (horn), a jazz band (trumpet), and a contemporary Christian quintet (bass guitar and vocals), as well as having served regularly as a church organist and pianist. His outstanding contributions to the concert and marching band literature have played an important role in the development of the contemporary band repertoire.

Ed holds a bachelor's degree in music education from East Central University in Ada, Oklahoma, a master's degree in music education from the University of Oklahoma, and a doctorate in administration from Oklahoma State University with additional study at the University of North Texas. He has written music education articles for *The Instrumentalist*, *The American Music Teacher*, and *The Journal of the International Horn Society*, and has held memberships in Music Educators National Conference, Oklahoma Music Educators Association, Oklahoma Bandmasters Association, ASCAP, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and Phi Beta Mu, where he served as a member of the national board of directors and state chapter president. Huckleby was selected as an "Outstanding Young Man in America," is listed in the "International Who's Who in Music," and was inducted into the Oklahoma Bandmasters Association "Hall of Fame" in 1996. He has created over 45 commissioned works and regularly serves as a clinician, adjudicator and conductor for instrumental ensembles around the world.

Dr. Craig Fuchs is Chair of the Department of Music and Associate Professor of Music at Pittsburg State University. His teaching responsibilities include conducting the Wind Ensemble, as well as teaching conducting and wind literature at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Dr. Fuchs holds degrees in music education from Missouri Western State College and the University of Missouri-Columbia. He holds a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Wind Conducting from the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music where his primary conducting mentor was Gary Hill. Fuchs has additional instruction through workshops with Jack Stamp, H. Robert Reynolds, and Anthony Meillo. Dr. Fuchs had ten years of teaching experience in the public schools of Kansas and Missouri prior to moving to the collegiate level.

Dr. Fuchs is active as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the Midwest. He has served on international adjudication panels in both Paris, France and Maastricht, The Netherlands. Fuchs was a member of the T.D. Pack Band, the official band of the Kansas City Chiefs, for 13 seasons. He recently had two articles published in The Instrumentalist magazine. Dr. Fuchs holds memberships in MENC, KMEA, CBDNA, Kappa Kappa Psi, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and is a member of the Pi Kappa Lambda Music Honor Society.
