1931. In the 1930s Mr. Cundiff worked as a salesman. In 1939 he married Inez Grace Miner, in Fort Scott, Kansas. They had one son. He served in the US Army during World War II, achieving the rank of major. After the war, he was office manager of Merker Machine Shop in Fort Scott, and in 1957 was a rural mail carrier. Roy Cundiff passed away in 1978 at the age of 66 and is buried in the Fort Scott National Cemetery.
