Robert Kehle

Mr. Kehle joined the Pittsburg State University faculty in 1978. He holds the rank of associate professor of music and teaches Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba and is the Director of the PSU Jazz Studies program. Bob holds both the B. M. degree and the B. A. (Music Education) degrees from Washington State University and a M. M. in Trombone degree from Indiana University where he has completed his doctoral course work. His trombone teachers include Dr. S. Thomas Beversdorf, Mr. Keith Brown, Mr. M. Dee Stewart and Mr. Edward Kleinhammer. He has performed with the Spokane Symphony, the Indiana Brass Quintet, Slide Hampton's World of Trombones, the Spokane Jazz Society, Mr. Louis Bellson and has been a featured soloist with the Music Festival of Arkansas, the Springfield and the Southeast Kansas Symphonies. Mr. Kehle is also Principal Trombone in the Springfield, MO Symphony Orchestra, is trombonist with the jazz group Blues Over Easy, the PSU Brass Quintet, the Central Plains Brass Quintet and is on the faculty of the Music Festival of Arkansas. Mr. Kehle is a former President of the Kansas Unity of hte International Association of Jazz Educators. He also is the host of "The Brass Odyssey" a special radio show featuring brass music.

Robert Laushman

Mr. Laushamn has attended the University of Kansas and West-Arkansas Community College. He has studied percussion with George Frock and Mrs. Russell Wiley. For the past 25 years, Bob has performed throughout the Midwest, playing with many jazz and rock bands as well as gaining extensive show experience with such artists as: Bob Hope, the Smothers Brothers, Phyllis Diller, and Nipsy Russell. His experience also includes the Barnum and Bailey/Ringling Brothers Circus, the Wichita State University Jazz Quartet and symphony experience with the Wichita and Fort Smith, AR Orchestras. Currently, he performs with the Pittsburg State University faculty Jazz Sextet, the Drive It Home Jazz Quintet, the Southeast Kansas Symphony and leads the PSU Percussion Ensemble.
