Robert Kehle joined the Pittsburg State University faculty in 1978. He holds the rank of associate professor of music and teaches Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba and is the Director of the PSU Jazz Studies program. Bob holds both the B. M. degree and the B. A. (Music Education) degree from Washington State University and a M. M. in Trombone degree from Indiana University where he has completed his doctoral course work. His trombone teachers include Dr. S. Thomas Beversdorf, Mr. Keith Brown, Mr. M. Dee Stewart and Mr. Edward Kleinhammer. He has performed with the Spokane Symphony, the Indiana Brass Quintet, Slide Hampton's World of Trombones, the Spokane Jazz Society, Mr. Louis Bellson and has been a featured soloist with the Music Festival of Arkansas, the Springfield and the Southeast Kansas Symphonies. Mr. Kehle is also Principal Trombone in the Springfield, MO Symphony Orchestra, is trombonist with the jazz group Blues Over Easy, the PSU Brass Quintet, the Central Plains Brass Quintet and is on the faculty of the Music Festival of Arkansas. He is a Past President of the International Association of Jazz Educators. Knasas Unit. He also is the host of "The Brass Odyssey" a special radio show featuring brass music and is an Artist Affiliate with Conn/United Musical Instruments.
