He heaps reproaches on the absent Lucy and then sees mourners coming from the castle. They tell him of Lucy's madness and her death. He sings his own dying prayer and expires.

Addio alla Madre, from "Cavalleria Rusticana".....*Mascagni*

Alfio, hearing of the unfaithfulness of his wife, Lola, challenges her lover to a duel. He bids farewell to his mother, "I pray you, give your son your blessing as when I left you to become a soldier! If I return not, you must not falter . . ."
